**ORDER THAT JUDGMENT OF AMERICAN EXPRESS CENTURION BANK  
IS SATISFIED, AVOIDED AND RELEASED**

This case is before the Court on the Debtor's Motion for Satisfaction of Judgment of American Express Centurion Bank. When the Debtor filed this bankruptcy case, she included on Schedule E/F a debt to "AMEX" for "Judgment 58-CV-2010-901091," and American Express Centurion Bank subsequently filed a proof of claim for an unsecured debt in the amount of \$7,041. In her Chapter 13 plan the Debtor proposed to pay 100% to unsecured creditors. American Express Centurion Bank never objected to the plan, and the plan was confirmed on July 20, 2016. Per the Chapter 13 Trustee's Final Report, the claim as filed was paid in full and the Debtor received her discharge on September 4, 2018. Despite being paid in full, American Express Centurion Bank has not released its lien. Because the Debtor has paid the claim as filed, in full, and without objection by American Express Centurion Bank, the Court finds that the judgment has been satisfied and the lien is due to be avoided and released. It is therefore

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED** that **JUDGMENT 58-CV-2010-901091** held by **AMERICAN EXPRESS CENTURION BANK** against **MELANIE JUNE PEELER, 1242 HIGHWAY 35, PELHAM, AL 35214** has been **SATISFIED** and is deemed to be **AVOIDED and RELEASED**.
