JUDGMENT

In accordance with the Order (<u>Doc. No. 31</u>) granting the Motion for Default Judgment filed by ServisFirst Bank (the "Plaintiff"), against Steven L. Russell (the "Defendant"), it is hereby **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED**, and **DECREED** as follows:

- A. The Clerk of Court entered the Defendant's default on October 5, 2018 (AP Doc. No. 11) for failure to plead or otherwise defend the Plaintiff's complaint. Pursuant to the Plaintiff's Amended Application for Entry of Default (AP <u>Doc. No. 28</u>), the Clerk of Court amended the Entry of Default on December 18, 2018 (AP <u>Doc. No. 29</u>).
- B. This Court held a hearing on the Plaintiff's Amended Motion for Default Judgment on January 9, 2019, and the Plaintiff presented evidence by documents and testimony sufficient to establish the truth of the allegations contained in the complaint pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55(b)(2)(C).

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- C. Now therefore, a **FINAL JUDGMENT** is entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in the amount of \$674,267.98;
- D. The amount of this judgment shall be nondischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 523(a)(2)(B), and this debt is excepted from discharge in the Defendant's underlying bankruptcy case and any other case he may file under the Bankruptcy Code;
- E. Interest shall accrue on the judgment at the rate set forth in <u>28 U.S.C. § 1961</u> from the date of entry hereof;
- F. This judgment is entered pursuant to Rule 7058 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and
- G. Upon the expiration of 14 days after the entry of the judgment, the Clerk of Court is directed to close this adversary proceeding.
