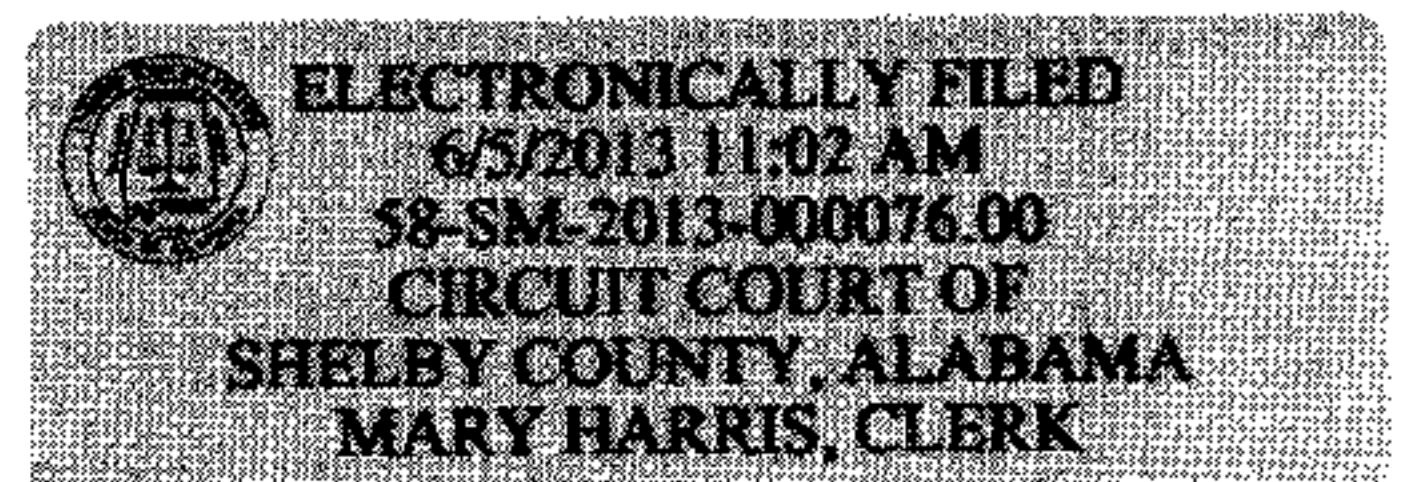

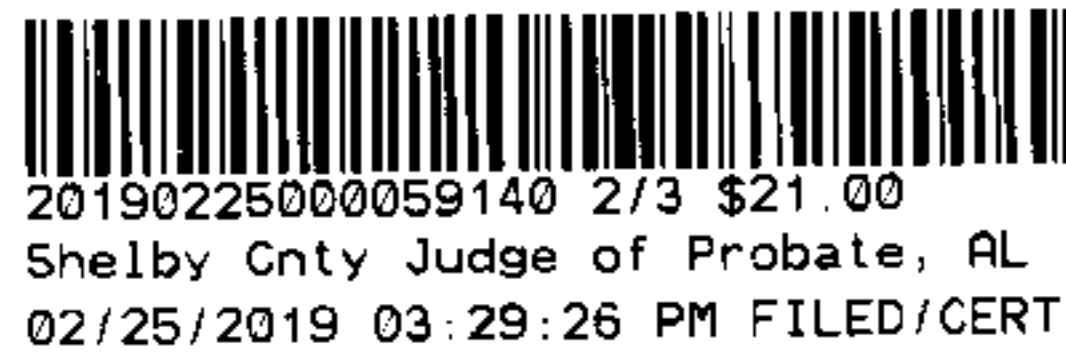

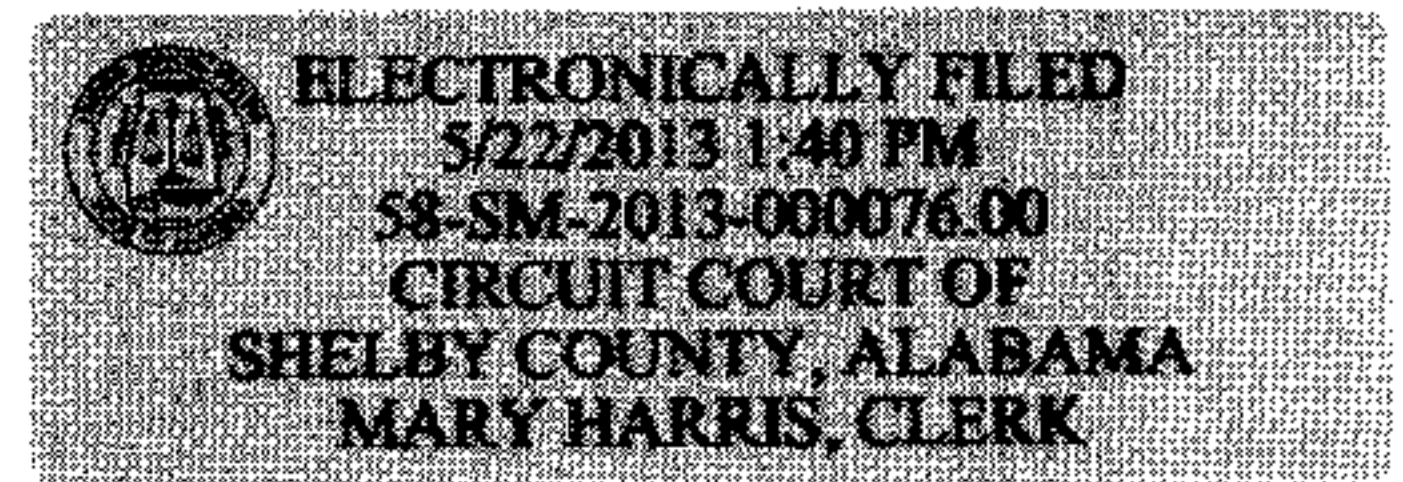
ORDER
