



## ORDER AND JUDGMENT

This case was called for trial on May 7, 2014. The Plaintiff was present with her counsel. The Defendant failed or refused to appear for trial. T During the trial, the Court took and received testimony and evidence from the Plaintiff and, having now considered same, hereby ORDERES as follows:

- 1. That judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff Lendsie Nesmith and against the Defendant, Harold Keith English and damages are awarded as follows:
- (a) The Court assesses compensatory damages to the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in the amount of \$150,000.00.
- (b) That Court assesses punitive damages to the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in the amount of \$500,000.00.
  - 2. That execution on this judgment may issue immediately.
  - 3. That this judgment is made and entered with waiver of personal exemption.
  - 4. That the costs of this action are taxed against the Defendant, Harold Keith English.
- 5. That because this judgment is entered after a finding of sexual assault upon the Plaintiff, a child or incapacitated adult by the Defendant, an adult, no relief or discharge shall be granted through bankruptcy or other proceeding for the discharge of lawful debts and/or judgments.
