I, Peter Belleus Thomas, a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, and over the age of Eighteen (18) years, being of sound mind and deposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, revoking all former wills and codicils which may have been made at any time heretofore by me.

FIRST: I hereby direct my Personal Representative to pay all funeral expenses and other debts as soon as practicable after my death I direct that all of my lawfully enforceable debts, the expenses of my last illness, the costs of administering my estate, including the reasonable expenses incurred in safeguarding or delivering estate property, shall be paid by my Personal Representative, hereinafter named, out of and charged generally against the principal of my residuary estate as soon as the prudent and orderly administration of my estate will permit. I direct that my body is to be cremated and that some of the ashes be placed with my mother and the remainder to be spread in the ocean off Williams Street approach in Daytona Beach where I spent my youth swimming and surfing. I do not wish for there to be an organized viewing or funeral service, however, my daughter Ashley may hold a tribute that she feels is appropriate.

SECOND: I will, bequeath and devise all my property, which may be mine at the time of my death, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to my daughters, Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas, in equal shares *per stirpes*, absolutely, to have and to hold, in fee simple forever, if Kirsten Atwood and/or Ashley Thomas should be living at the time of my death. I hereby direct that if any disagreements arise between the beneficiaries that said disputes will be resolved by my sister, Pam Thomas.

THIRD: In the event that the death of both Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas should occur prior to my death, or simultaneously with the time of my death, and with no surviving issue of either, I will, bequeath, and devise all property which may be mine at the time of my death, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated, to my sister, Pam Thomas, to have and to hold, in fee simple forever.

FOURTH: I hereby nominate and appoint my daughters, Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas, to serve as Co-Administrators of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and I hereby declare that they shall not be required to make or file any inventory, settlement, or report to any court for the actions of Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas, nor to give bond for the performance of said duties hereunder as Co-Administrators of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT.

I hereby grant to and vest in my said Co-Administrators full power and authority to continue the operation of any business activity in which I may be engaged at the time of my death, together with full power and authority to sell, at private or public sale, and to convey, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge, to otherwise alienate any or all of the assets of my estate, on such terms as Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas deems to be proper without the order of

any Court, it being my purpose and intention to grant to my said Co-Administrators all the powers over my said property and estate that I am capable of granting to Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas as such Co-Administrators, all without the order or approval of any Court. In the event that one of my Co-Administrators should not be living at the time of my death, or if Kirsten Atwood and Ashley Thomas for any reason fail to serve and qualify as Co-Administrator, the surviving or qualified individual will serve solely. In the event that neither Kirsten Atwood nor Ashley Thomas survive or fail to qualify, then I nominate and appoint my sister, Pam Thomas, as Alternate Administrator of this my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, with all the powers, duties, and exemptions granted to and vested in my said Co-Administrators as such Administrator.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Peter Belleus Thomas, the undersigned, sign my name to this instrument this 9th day of July, 2019, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT and that I sign it willingly, and that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed, and that I am Eighteen (18) years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.

Thomas is Eighteen (18) years of age or older, of sound mind, and under no constraint or undue influence.

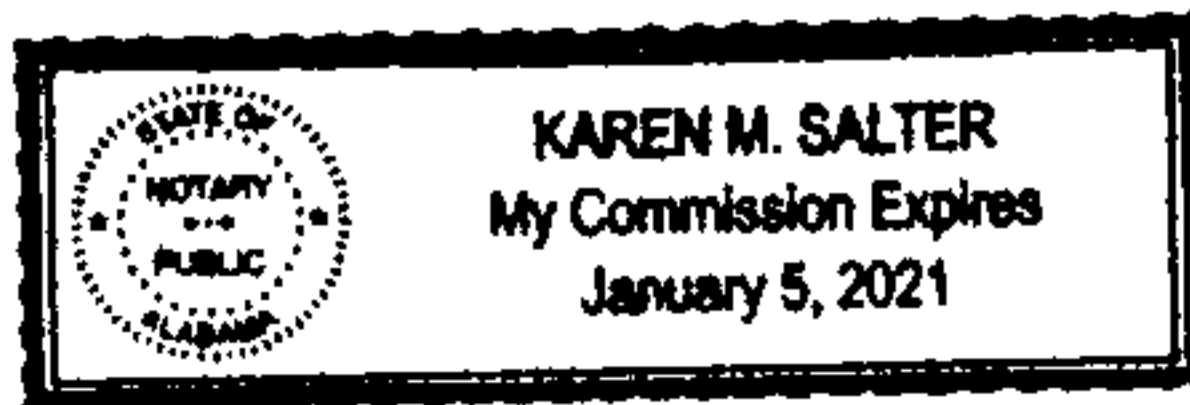

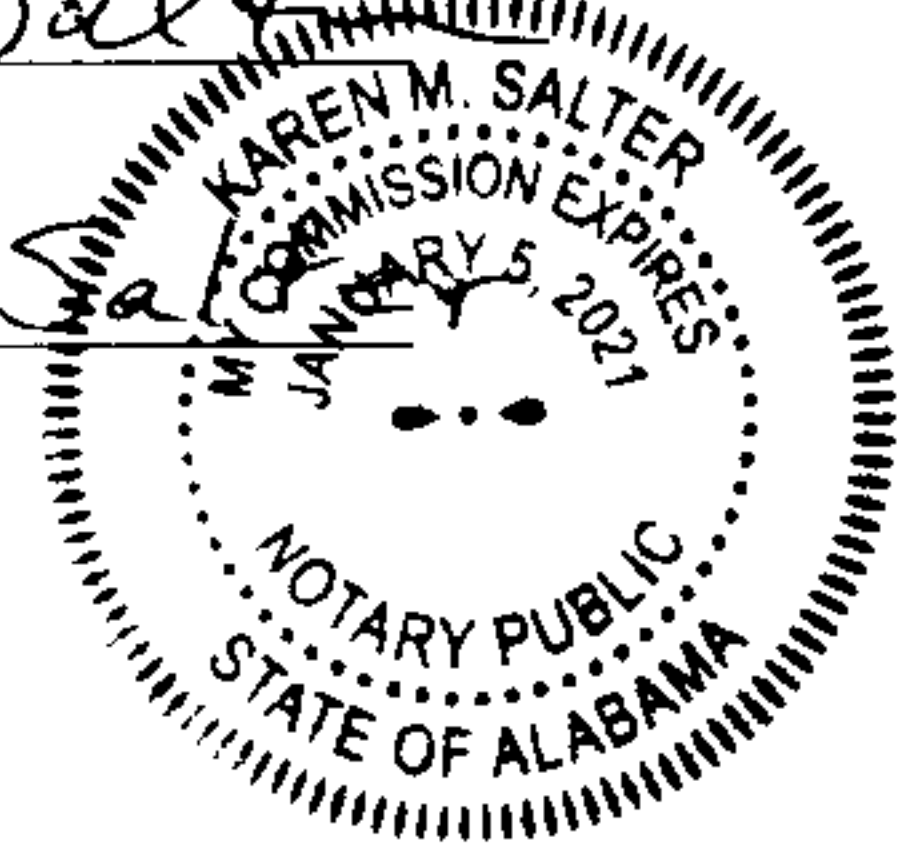
