CERTIFICATE OF TRUST

4. The name and address of the trustee empowered to act under the Trust Agreement at the time of the execution of this Certificate of Trust are:



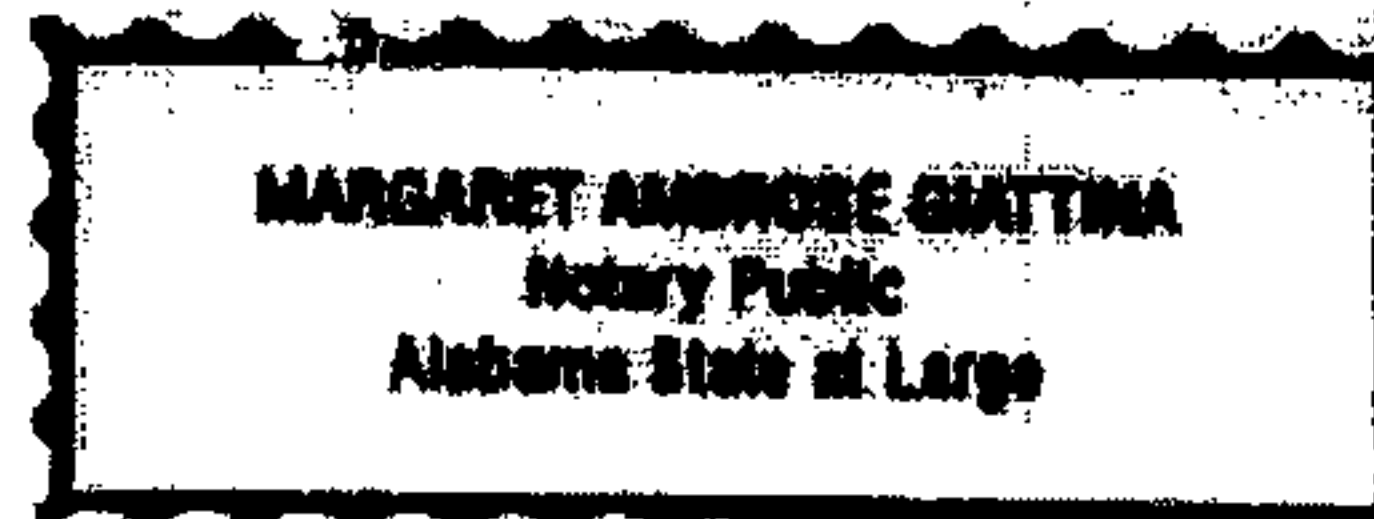
