I, Sharon Harris, Clerk of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama, do hereby certify that a Judgment was rendered by the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Divison and registered in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama on the 16th day of June, 2017, in the above-styled cause wherein: Plaintiff, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, as receiver for Silvertron Bank, National Association obtained an Amended Judgment against Defendants Donald V. Watkins, Kenneth L. Thomas, Lawrence R. Tate and Clarissa Harms as set forth in the Court's October 2, 2014 order. As to the First Watkins Loan, the FDIC is awarded \$1,255,411.90 against defendant Donald V. Watkins. Defendant Kenneth L. Thomas is liable for this amount to the extent of his 44,800 shares of stock in Alamerica BancCorp. The FDIC is also awarded attorney's fees on this loan against defendant Donald V. Watkins only, in the amount of \$188,131.79. As to the Second Watkins Loan, the Thomas Loan, the Tate Loan and Harms Loan, the FDIC is awarded \$2,947,862.63 against defendants Donald V. Watkins, Kenneth L. Thomas, Lawrence R. Tate and Clarissa Harms, jointly and severally, plus attorney's fees in the amount of \$441,654.39 on those four loans.
