**ALABAMA POWER OF ATTORNEY**

**AUTHORITY**

This Power of Attorney is executed and delivered by Frank Roy Wilson, pursuant to the authority of the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act as set forth in Title 26-1A-101, et seq., *Code of Alabama, 1975*, being Alabama Legislative Act number 11-683, which became effective on January 1, 2012.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ACKNOWLEDGED BY FRANK ROY WILSON**

This power of attorney authorizes another person (your agent) to make decisions concerning your property for you (the principal). Your agent will be able to make decisions and act with respect to your property (including your money) whether or not you are able to act for yourself. 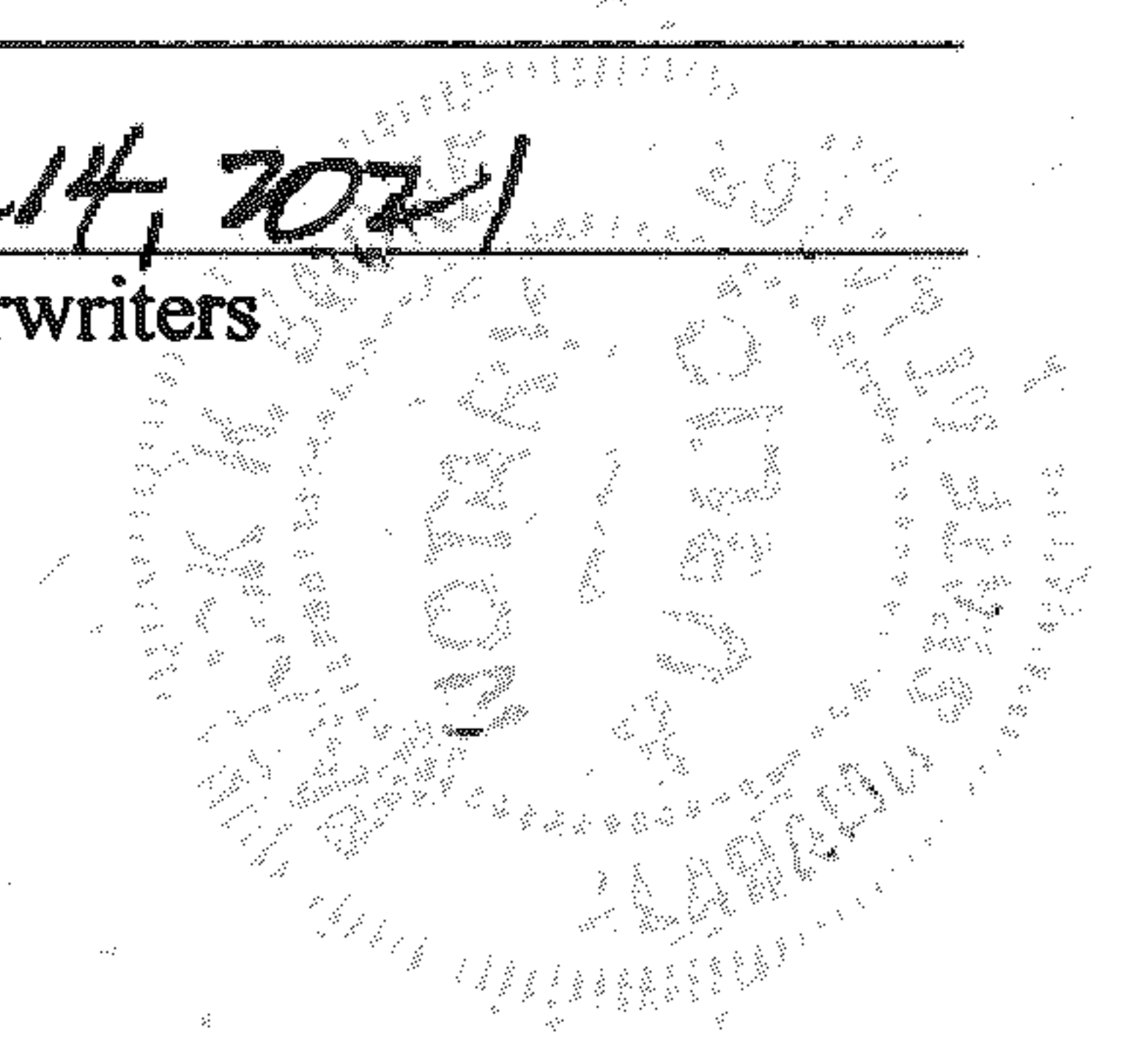



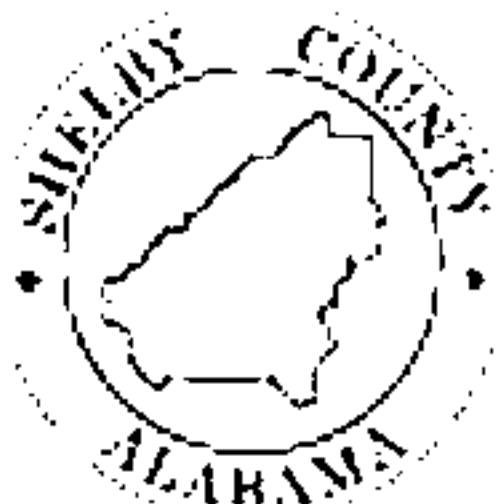
