LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

Letters of Administration on the estate of JAMES T. FERGUSON, ESQ., are hereby granted to JILL T. KARLE, ESQ., who has duly qualified as such Personal Representative(s), and is authorized to administer such estate. Subject to the priorities stated in Ala. Code, §43-8-76 (1975, as amended), the said personal representative, acting prudently for the benefit of interested persons, has all the powers authorized in transactions under Ala. Code, §43-2-843 (1975, as amended) subject to the following restrictions: No assets of decedent may be sold, transferred or encumbered in any way and further provided that the Personal Representative is prohibited from settling litigation, including an asbestos lawsuit, receiving funds, assets or property of any kind without prior order of this Court. No funds shall be paid directly to the personal representative. All funds shall be paid to the Shelby County Probate Court. The Personal Representative's authority extends only to the filing of a wrongful death lawsuit.
