Cleveland, a married man, and Frances P. Cleveland, a married woman (formally husband and wife)**, (herein referred to as grantors), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **William James McCoy and Margaret Taylor McCoy**, (herein referred to as grantees), for and during their joint lives, and upon death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in **Shelby County, Alabama**, to wit:

Lot 9, according to King's Meadow First Sector, as recorded in Map Book 9, Page 167 and amended in Map Book 10, Page 12, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.


For ad valorem tax purposes only, the address to the above described property is 1701 King James Drive, Alabaster, AL 35007.

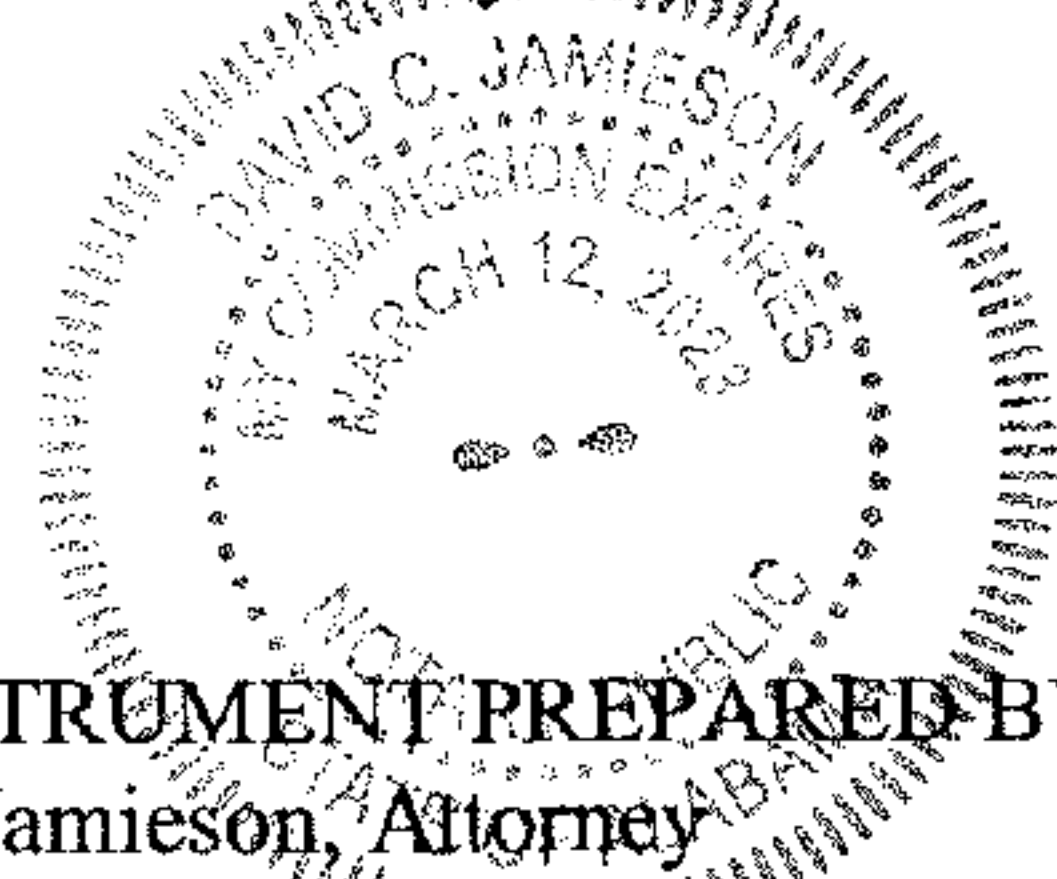
