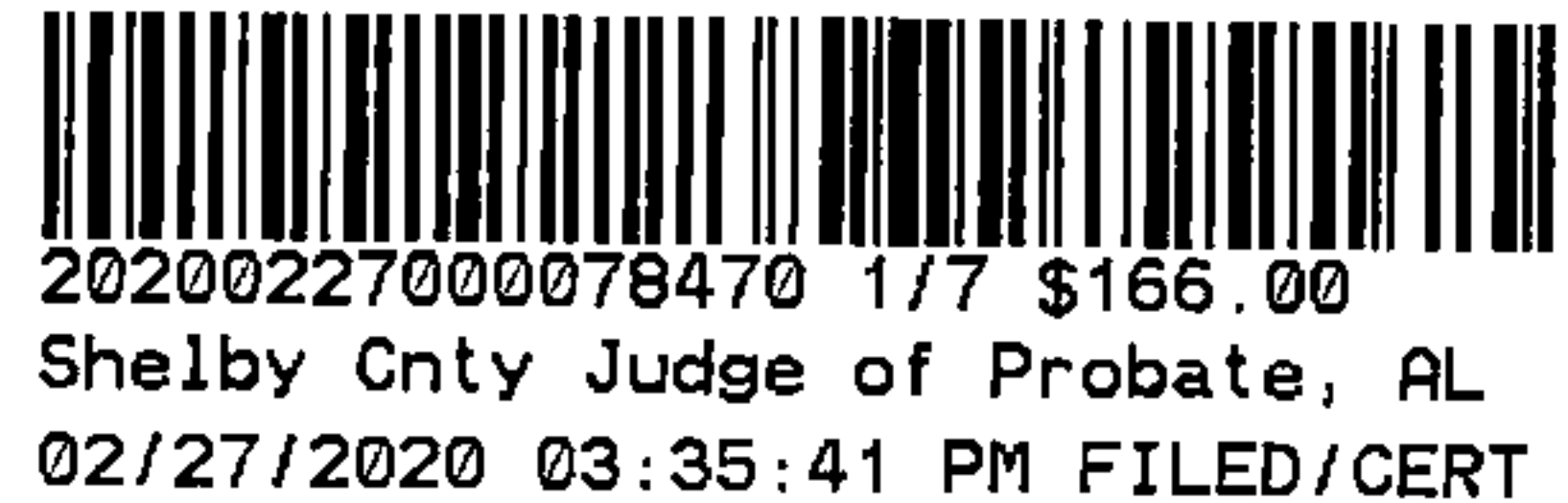




ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

RESTORATION CHRISTIAN CENTER MINISTRIES, INC.

A Nonprofit Organization

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Nonprofit Business Corporation

Act, Undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I: The name of the corporation is:

Restoration Christian Center Ministries, Inc.

Article II: The duration:

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

Article III: Purpose (s):

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed

are as more fully set forth in the Restoration Christian Center

Ministries bylaws or as may hereafter, from time to time, be

amended including:

(a). To teach, preach and study the gospel of Christ; to advance its membership in faith, hope, and charity; to promote the advancement and glory of Christ's Kingdom by missionary, benevolent, and Sunday School work;

(b). To train, license, ordain, appoint, and/or engage evangelists,

pastors, preachers, teachers, ministers and other qualified persons to actively pursue and accomplish the purposes of the Corporation;

(c.) To spread the Word of God by ministering to all individuals through workshops, radio, television and other forms of mass media;

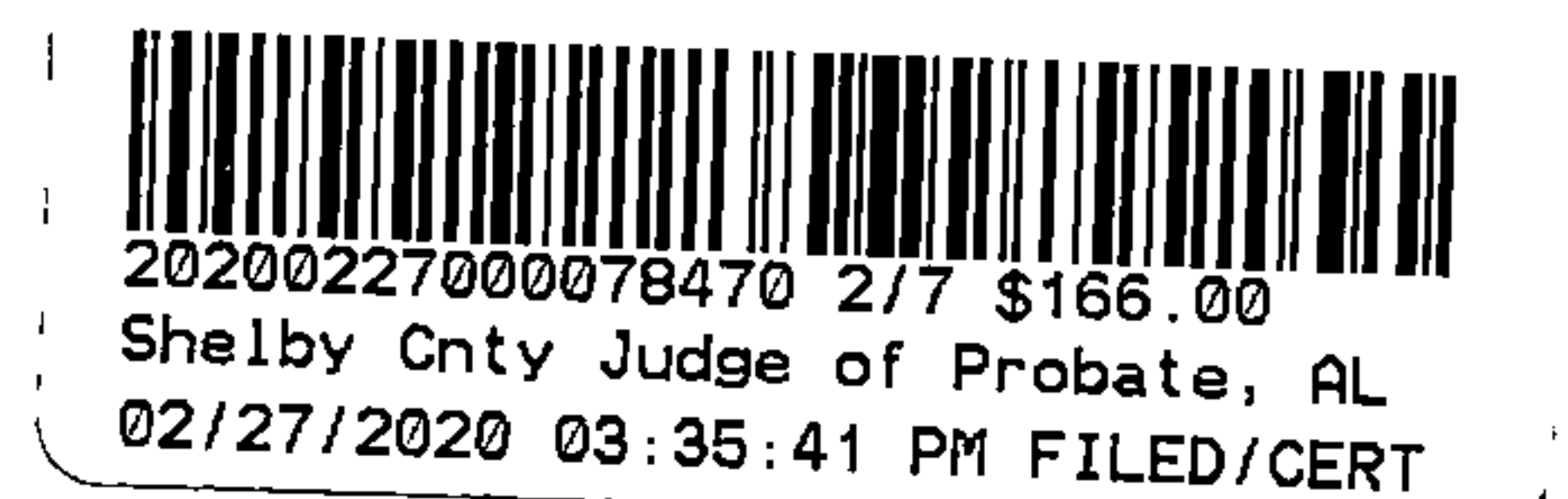
(d). To promote, organize, conduct and maintain Bible conferences, revivals, community outreach programs and evangelical campaigns in the metropolitan and surrounding areas of Birmingham, Alabama and throughout the State of Alabama;

(e). To carry on and operate general religious services, prayer meetings, Sunday schools and general Church activities and programs.

(f). To acquire and administer funds and property which, after the payment of necessary expenses, shall be devoted exclusively to the purposed set forth above, and as set forth in the bylaws for the Corporation.

(g). To do any and all things necessary or incident to the accomplishment or such purposes.

The corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The purpose of the corporation is to also engage in the



transaction of any or all-lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under this chapter.

Article IV: Members:

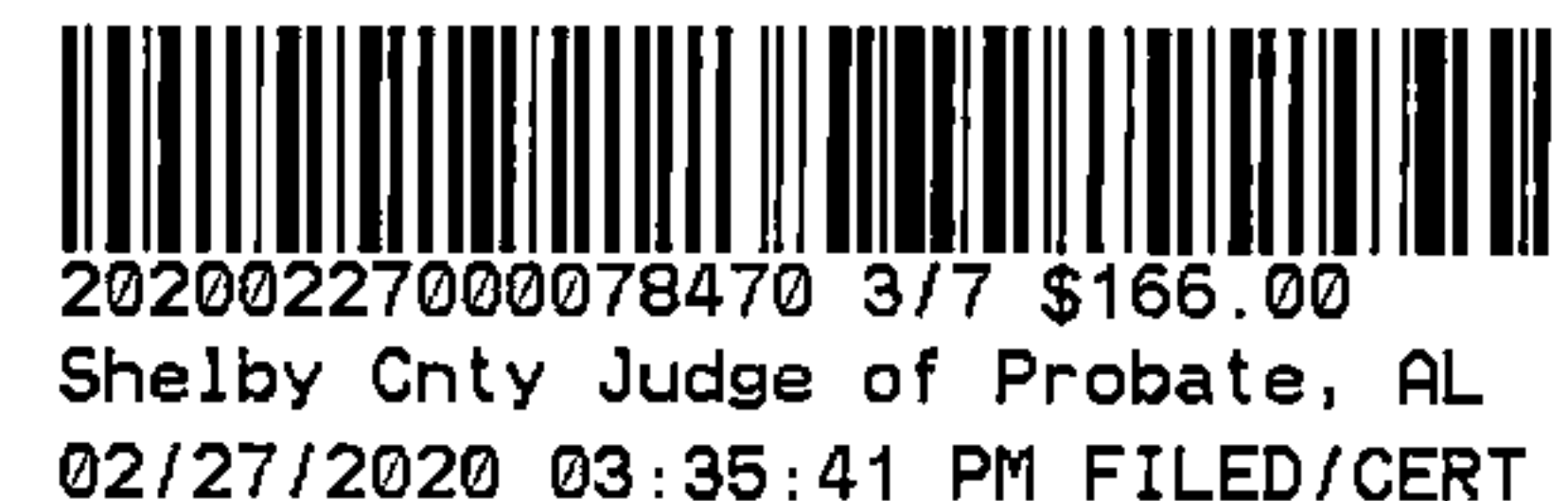
This church shall receive as members only those who have by faith accepted and baptized into Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, and who are willing to live in harmony with the organization's Statement of Faith and bylaws, and who are willing to regularly and faithfully attend services and support the ministry of this church.

The members of the corporation shall mean the membership of the church and shall be composed of such persons ministerial and lay as from time to time shall be defined in accordance with the church bylaws, and such members thereof shall have only such voting and other rights as now exist or may hereafter be granted by the organization through its bylaws.

Article V: Registered Office/Agent:

The location and street address of the initial registered office is 100 Brookside Way, Calera, AL 35040, and the name of its initial registered agent as such address is J. Lamar Baker.

Article VI: Board of Directors:



The number of Board of Directors shall be no less than three (3) and no more than thirteen (13) members. The initial directors' names and addresses are:

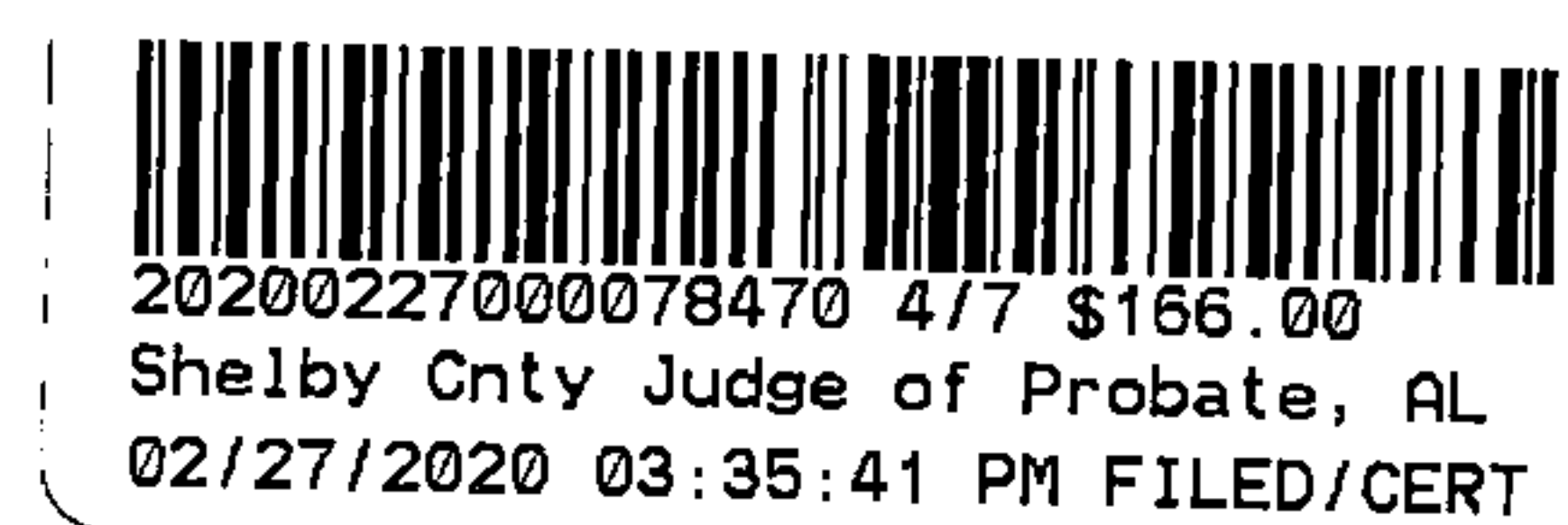

Article VIII: Additional Provisions:

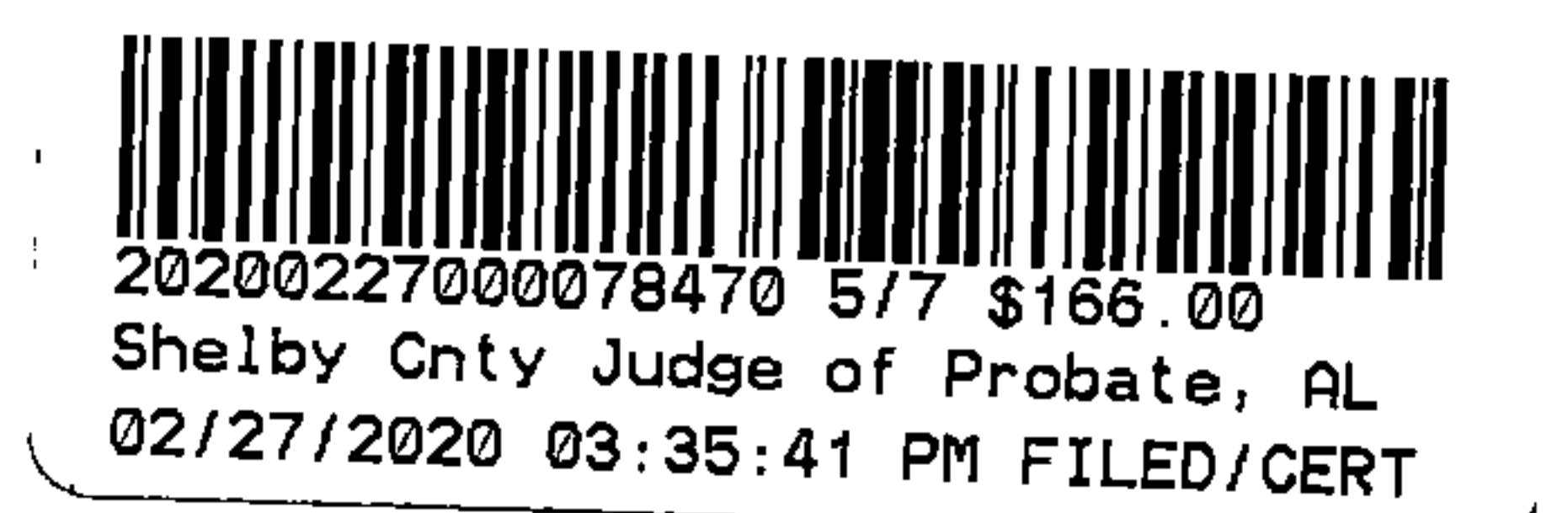
The Corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property of the Corporation and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any Director or any other private individual. The corporation shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit,



nor shall the Corporation be authorized to engage in any other activity, which is not in furtherance of the purposes stated herein.

The Corporation shall never engage in propaganda, neither shall it attempt to influence legislation or participate in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, nor shall any part of its property or any part of the income there from be devoted to such purposes.

In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, no member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and all of the assets of the Corporation shall be used or distributed to, or its assets shall be sold and the proceeds therefore used or distributed exclusively to another organization organized and operating for the purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and such other organization shall be selected and approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. If for any reason upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall fail to act in the manner herein provided within a reasonable time of dissolution of the Corporation, then the senior Judge of the Superior Court of Shelby County, Alabama shall make such distribution as herein provided upon the application of one or more persons having a real interest in the corporation or its assets.



The property, assets, profits, and net income of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable, educational, and religious purposes and no part of the profits or net income of this church shall never inure to the benefit of any member, shareholder, or individual. Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision of all debts and liabilities of this Corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation that is organized and operated for charitable, educational, ecclesiastical, religious, or sacerdotal purposes and that has established its tax exempt status under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
