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DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

ARTICLE 1

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Durable Power of Attorney, that I, MILDRED M.. SCHMIDT, the undersigned, of Mobile County, Alabama, do hereby make, constitute and appoint my spouse, HARRY H.. SCHMIDT, as my Agent for me and in my name, place and stead and on my behalf and for my use and benefit. In the event he does not serve or ceases to serve, I hereby appoint my son, JOHN J. SCHMIDT, as my Agent.

To exercise or perform any act, power, duty, right or obligation whatsoever that I now have, or may hereafter acquire the legal right, power, or capacity to exercise or perform, in connection with, arising from, or relating to any person, item, transaction, thing, business or property, real or personal, tangible or intangible.

To request, ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, receive and hold and possess all such sums of money, debts, dues, commercial paper, checks, drafts, accounts, deposits, legacies, bequests, devises, notes, interests, stock certificates, bonds, dividends, certificates of deposit, annuities, pension and retirement benefits, insurance benefits and proceeds, any and all documents of title, choses in action, personal and real property, tangible and intangible property and property rights, and demands whatsoever, liquidated or unliquidated, as now are, or shall hereafter become owned by me, or due, owing, payable, or belonging to me, or in which I have or may hereafter acquire an interest, to have, use and take all lawful means and legal remedies in my name for the collection and recovery thereof, and to adjust, sell, compromise, and agree for the same, and to make, execute and deliver for me, on my behalf, and in my name, all endorsements, releases, receipts or other sufficient discharges for the same;

To sell, lease, purchase, hold, exchange, and acquire and to bargain and contract for the purchase, exchange and acquisition of, and to accept, take, receive and possess any real or personal

in my name and under such terms and conditions and under such covenants, as my said Agent shall deem proper;

To conduct, engage in and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on my behalf, and in my name; to sell, purchase and trade in stocks, bonds and other securities;

To borrow money, and to make, receive, sign, endorse, execute, acknowledge, deliver and possess applications, contracts, agreements, options, covenants, conveyances, deeds, trust deeds, security agreements, bills of sale, leases, mortgages, assignments, insurance policies, documents of title, bills, bonds, debentures, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, letters of credit, notes, stock certificates, proxies, warrants, commercial paper, receipts, withdrawal receipts and deposit instruments relating to accounts or deposits in, or certificates of deposits of, banks, savings and loan associations, credit unions, or other financial institutions or associations.

ARTICLE II

I grant to my said Agent full power and authority to do, take and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite, proper, or necessary to be done, in the exercise of any of the rights and powers herein granted, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney in Fact, or substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power of attorney and the rights and powers herein granted.

ARTICLE III

To execute all documents necessary or desirable for my admission to, treatment in or discharge from any medical facility whatsoever, to review my hospital and medical records, to confer with my physicians and to consent to medical tests, treatments or procedures, including surgery, for me as if I were fully competent to do so personally, and to consent to the termination of such procedures.

ARTICLE IV

This instrument is to be construed and interpreted as a **Durable and General Power of Attorney**. The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts, or powers herein is not intended to, nor

force and effect immediately upon the incapacity of the undersigned, as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction or by the written statement of a practicing physician or an attorney-at-law or a licensed psychologist selected by my said Agent; and such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until the death of the undersigned, or until the incapacity of the undersigned is otherwise terminated. Any action taken in good faith pursuant to the foregoing authority without actual knowledge of my death shall be binding upon me, my heirs, assigns and personal representatives.

Such power granted to my Agent shall remain in full force and effect in the event of my incapacity.

ARTICLE VI

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, as Principal, I have signed this Durable Power of Attorney at Mobile, Alabama, this 4 day of MAY, 2014, in several counterpart originals, each of which shall have full force and effect.

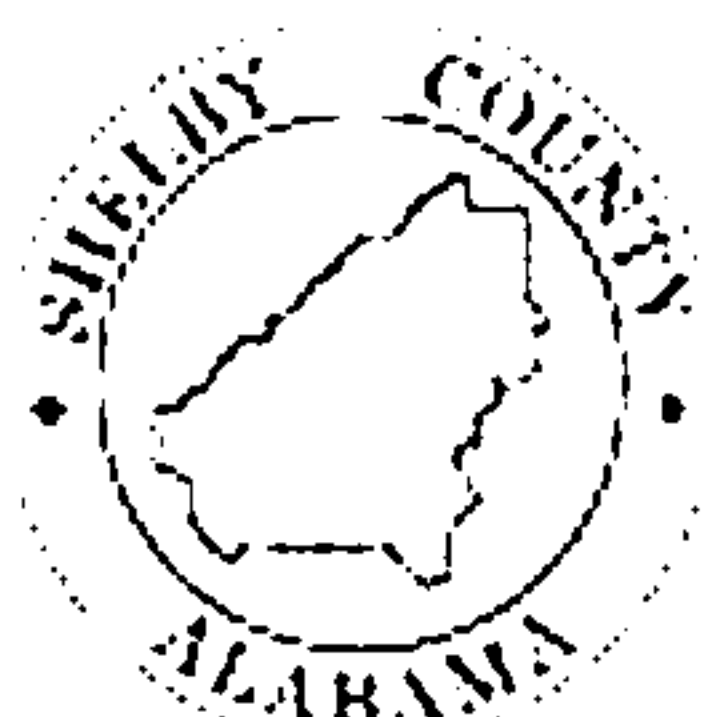
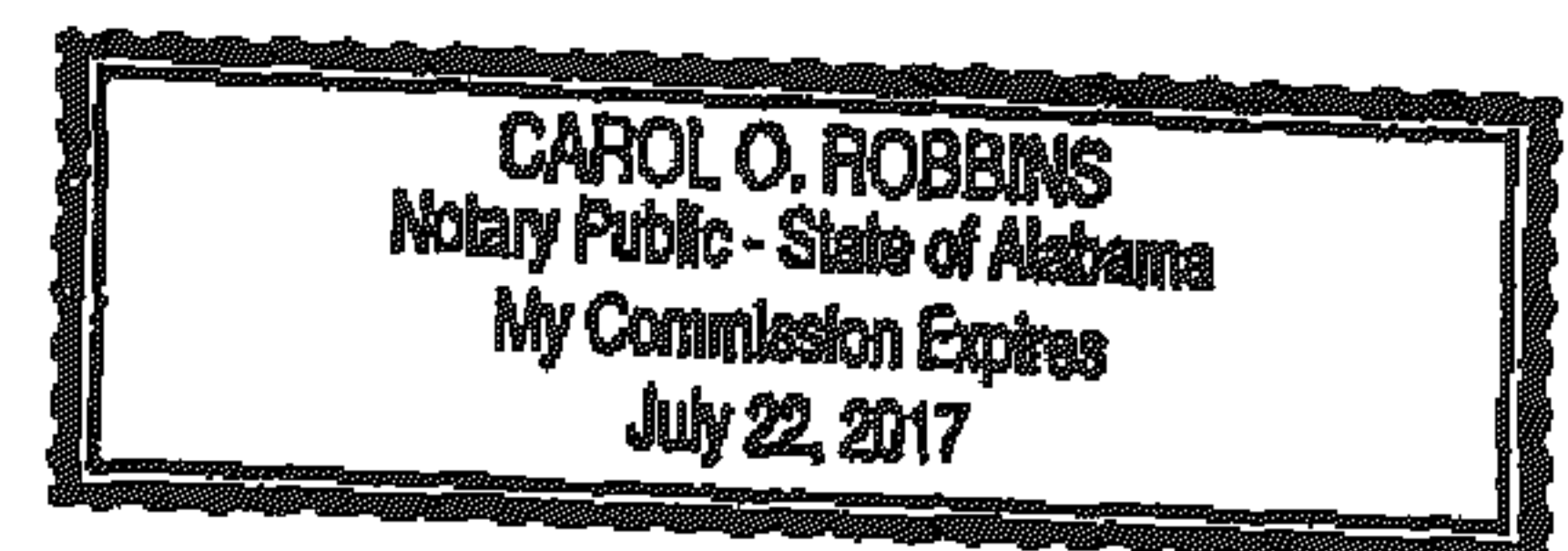
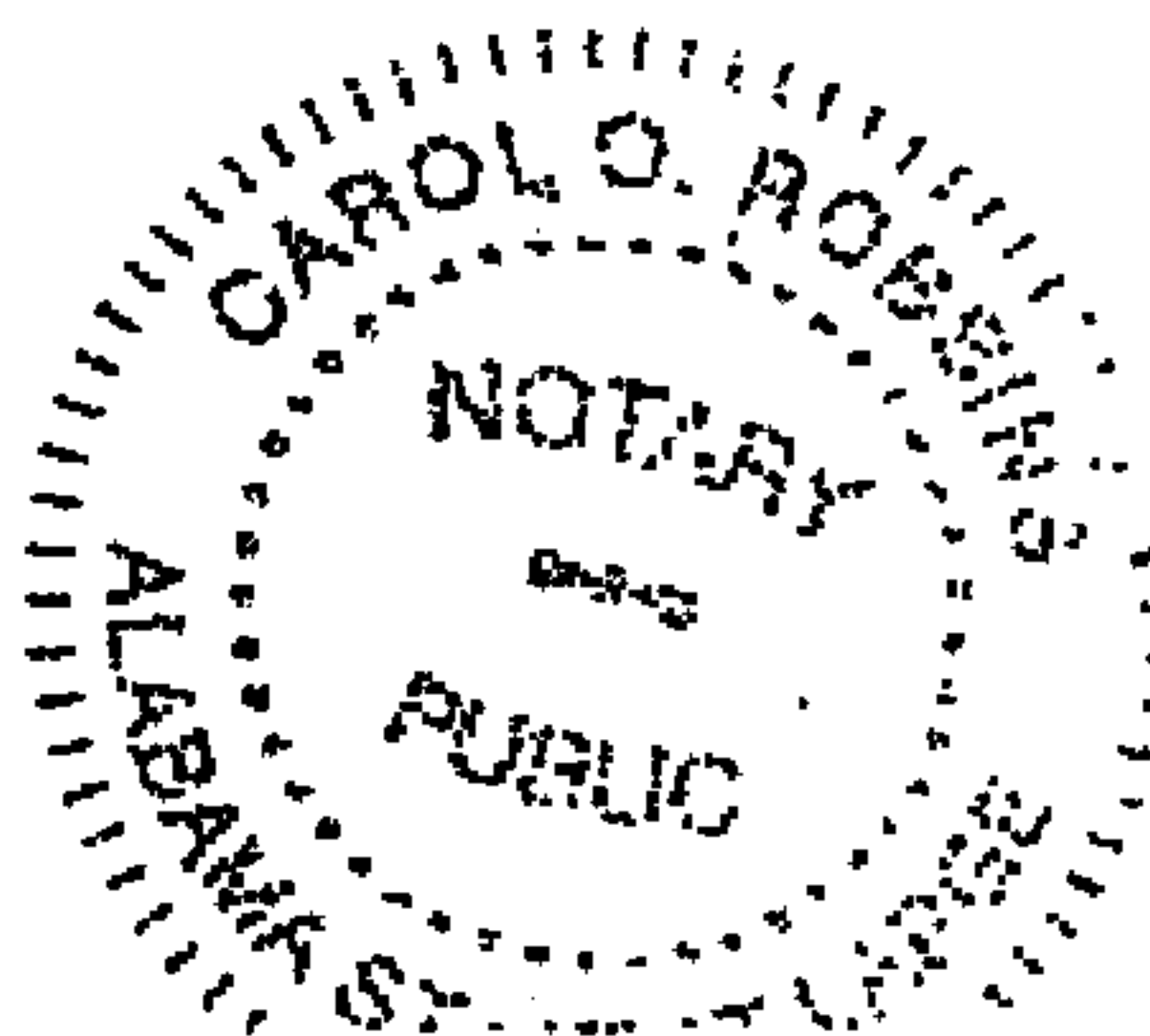
