WARRANTY DEED, JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP

SHELBY COUNTY KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of One and no/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00) to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, the undersigned Reenita K. Vest and husband, Darryl Ray Vest (herein referred to as GRANTOR, whether one or more) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Reenita K. Vest and Darryl Ray Vest (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:
