1. That the Court specifically directs the immediate entry of judgment and the immediate issuance of a writ of possession against Defendant Jack Wilborn Roper for the property sued for; to wit:

3. The Plaintiff shall have and recover of the Defendant Jack Wilborn Roper the sum of \$101,706.27 which is the amount due and owing on the collateral financing contract, plus interest, \$ 0, attorney fees and costs of Court, which are taxed to the Defendant Jack Wilborn Roper.

4. In the event the Plaintiff recovers the Collateral as described above in Paragraph No. 1 of this Judgment, the Plaintiff shall dispose of said Collateral in a commercially reasonable manner and apply the net proceeds of the sale thereof as a credit to the Judgment entered against said Defendant in Paragraph No. 3 above, and the Judgment previously entered against Co-Defendant James M.
