LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

PATRICIA REED GARDNER

I, **Patricia Reed Gardner**, make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, revoking all wills and codicils at any time heretofore made by me. I am married to **Patricia Reed Gardner**. I am married to **W. Carroll Gardner, Jr.** and I have four children whose names are **Richard C. Gardner, Michael R. Gardner, James R. Gardner, and David B. Gardner**. I reside and am domiciled in Jefferson County, Alabama.

FIRST: I direct that the expenses of my last illness and funeral, the expenses of the administration of my estate, and all estate, inheritance and similar taxes payable with respect to property included in my estate, whether or not passing under this will, and any interest or penalties thereon, shall be paid out of my residuary estate, without apportionment and with no right of reimbursement from any recipient.

SECOND: A certain portion of my furniture, furnishings, household goods, ornaments, clothing, jewelry, automobiles, and other personal effects shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of a certain written memorandum signed by me, the terms of which are incorporated herein by this reference.

If for any reason such memorandum is not found and properly identified as such by my personal representative within thirty (30) days after the presentation of my Will for probate, this gift shall be void and of no effect, and all of the aforesaid property shall be disposed of as hereinafter provided.

THIRD: I give all the rest, residue and remainder of my property and estate, both real and personal, of whatever kind and wherever located, that I own or to which I shall be in any manner entitled at the time of my death (collectively referred to as my "residuary estate"), as follows:

- (a) If my husband survives me, all to my husband outright.
- (b) If my husband does not survive me, then I give the balance of my estate to those of my children who survive me and to the issue who survive me of those of my children who predecease me, in equal shares per stirpes.

FOURTH: If any property of my estate vests in absolute ownership in a minor or incompetent, my personal representative, at any time and without court authorization, may: distribute the whole or any part of such property to the beneficiary; or use the whole or any part for the health, education, maintenance and support of the beneficiary; or distribute the whole or any part to a guardian, committee or other legal representative of the beneficiary, or to a custodian for the beneficiary under any gifts to minors or transfers to minors act, or to the person or persons with whom the beneficiary resides. Evidence of any such distribution or the receipt therefor executed by the person to whom the distribution is made shall be a full discharge of my personal representative from any liability with respect thereto, even though my personal representative may be such person. If such beneficiary is a minor, my personal representative may defer the distribution of the whole or any part of such property until the beneficiary attains the age of twenty-one (21) years, and may hold the same as a separate fund for the beneficiary with all of the powers described in Article SIXTH hereof. If the beneficiary dies before

attaining said age, any balance shall be paid and distributed to the estate of the beneficiary.

I direct that in any proceeding involving my estate it shall not be necessary to serve process upon, or to make a party to the proceeding, any person under a disability if another party to the proceeding who is not under a disability has the same interest as the person under a disability. The written approval by all of the then living adult beneficiaries of this will of any matter relating to the administration of my estate, whether the same relates to an accounting or any other action taken or omitted or proposed to be taken or omitted by my personal representative, shall be deemed to be the approval of and shall be binding upon all beneficiaries hereunder including those who are minors or are not yet born at the time of such action.

FIFTH: I appoint my husband **W. Carroll Gardner, Jr.** to be my personal representative. If my wife does not survive me, or shall fail to qualify for any reason as my personal representative, or having qualified shall die, resign or cease to act for any reason as my personal representative, I appoint my son, **Richard C. Gardner** as my personal representative. I vest in my personal representative herein named full power and authority to handle, manage and deal with my estate as freely as I could act if I were living. Such power and authority may be exercised independently and without the prior or subsequent approval of any court or judicial authority. No one dealing with my personal representative shall be required to inquire into the propriety of any action taken by my personal representative. I direct that no personal representative shall be required to file or furnish any bond, surety or other security in any jurisdiction. No personal representative shall be required to file or furnish any inventory or to file or furnish any account of their proceedings or of the property which may come into their possession or to make any report of any kind to any court. Nothing herein,

however, shall be construed as limiting the right of my personal representative to seek a judicial settlement of any account. My personal representative shall maintain proper books and records reflecting all income, disbursements and other transactions of my estate, and shall make such books and records accessible to the beneficiaries hereunder and other parties having an interest in my estate, at reasonable times after notice.

SIXTH: I grant to my personal representative all powers conferred upon personal representatives and executors wherever my personal representative may act. I also grant to my personal representative power to retain, sell at public or private sale, exchange, grant options on, invest and reinvest, and otherwise deal with any kind of property, real or personal, for cash or on credit; to borrow money and encumber or pledge any property to secure loans; to pay any legacy or distribute, divide or partition property in cash or in kind, or partly in kind, and to allocate different kinds of property, disproportionate amounts of property and undivided interests in property among any parts, funds or shares; to determine the fair valuation of property, with or without regard to tax basis; to determine what property shall receive basis increases pursuant to Section 1022(b) and (c) of the Internal Revenue Code and the amount of such increases, and to make such determinations without regard to any duty of impartiality as between different beneficiaries; to exercise all powers of an absolute owner of property; to compromise and release claims with or without consideration; and to employ attorneys, accountants and other persons for services or advice. The term "personal representative" wherever used herein shall mean the personal representatives, executors, executor, executrix or administrator in office from time to time.

My son Jim and my grandson John David Gardner have been of considerable assistance to me in the past and I place great trust in both of them. Jim is a real estate broker and John David is a personal financial planner. Accordingly,

SEVENTH: If any beneficiary under this will and I die in a common accident or under circumstances in which it is difficult or impractical to determine who survived the other, such beneficiary shall be deemed to have predeceased me.
