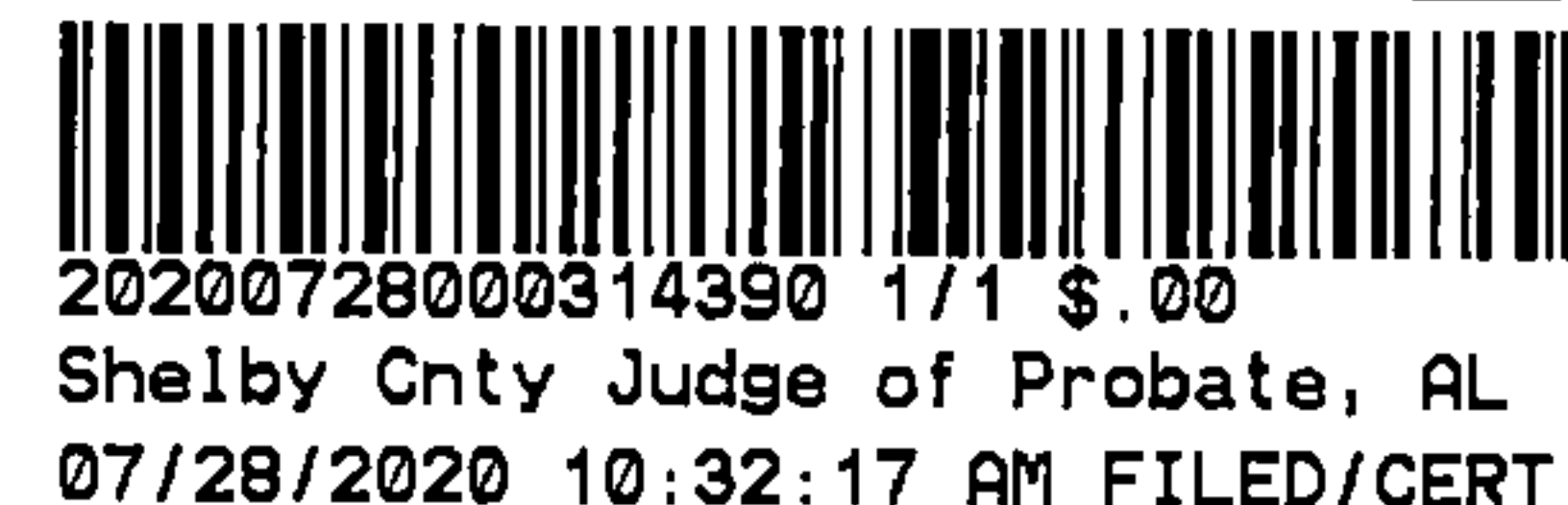

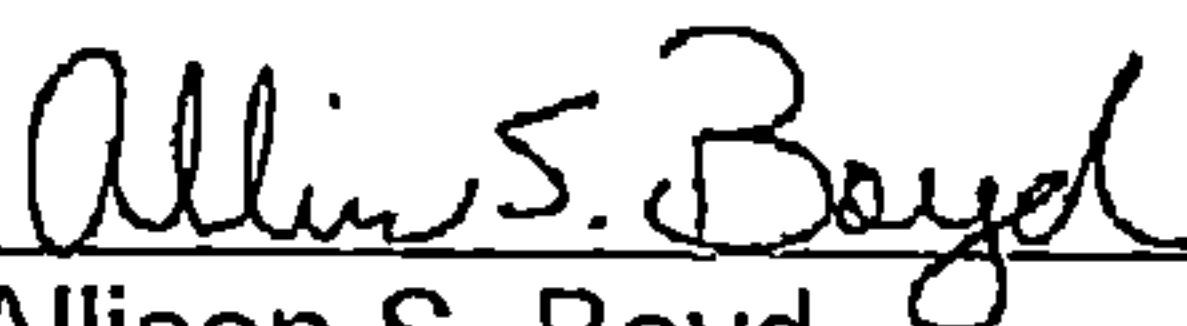

The Personal Representative shall obtain approval of this Court prior to selling or otherwise disposing of any estate property.

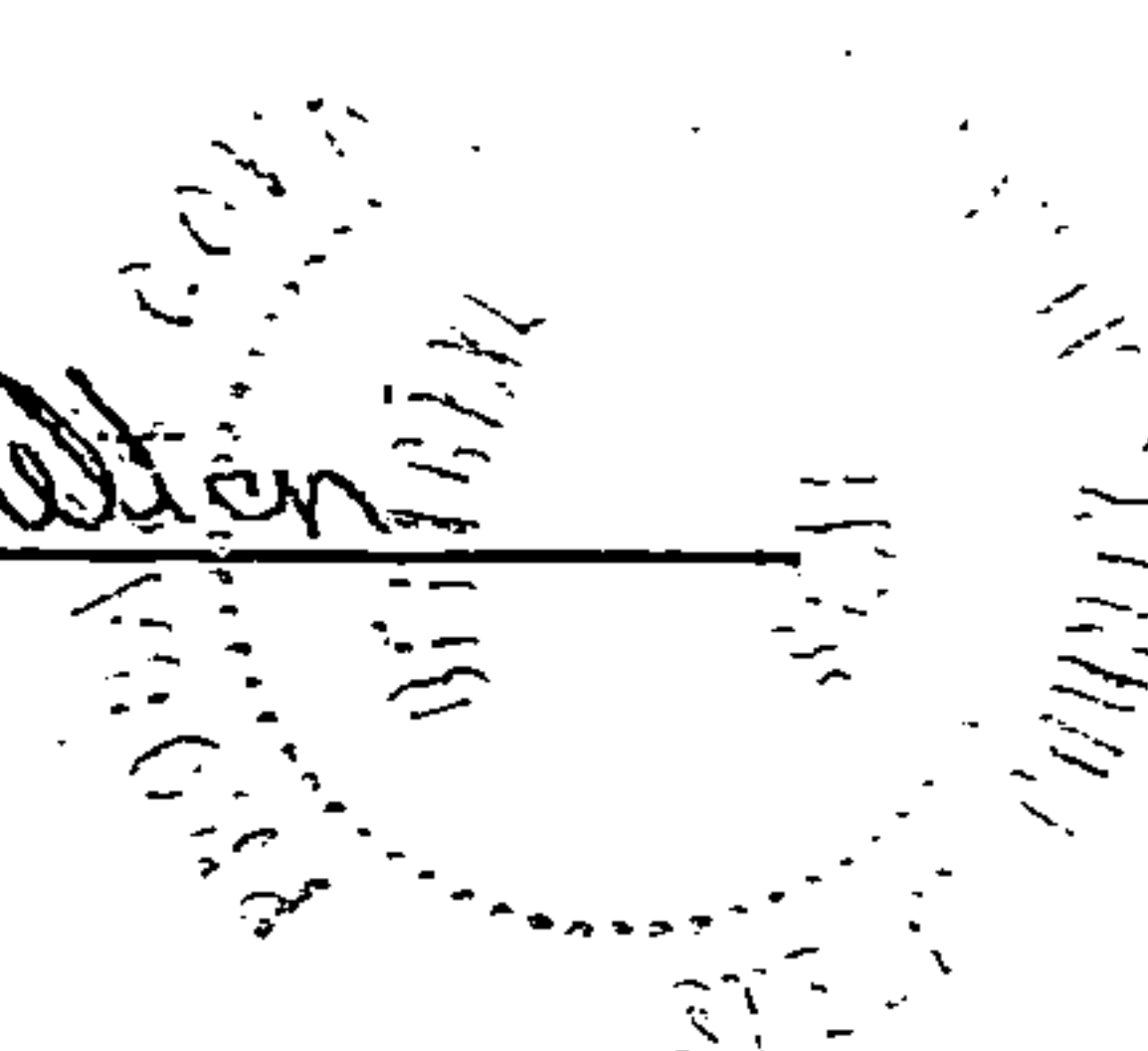
