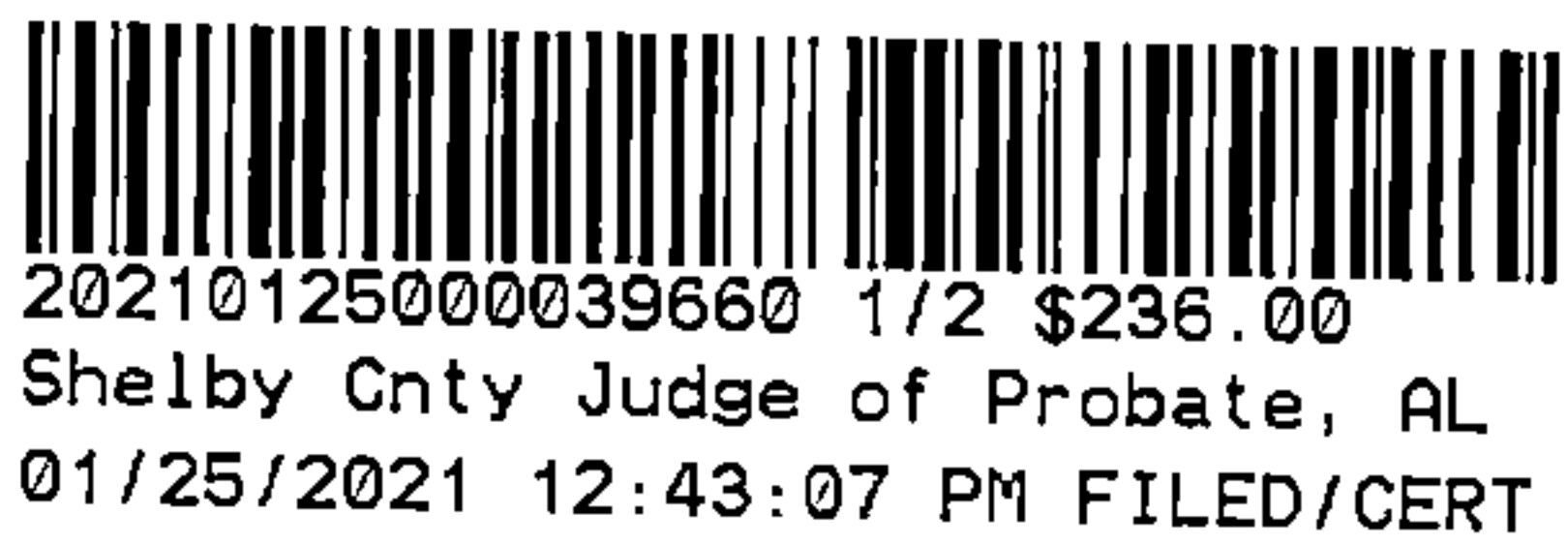

COUNTY OF SHELBY) **JOINT SURVIVORSHIP DEED**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of **Two Hundred Ten Thousand and 00/100 (\$210,000.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned **Mary Nell Wyatt, a single woman** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTOR does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **Timmerman Norris and Beverly Norris and Bethani Blair Boyer** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 5, according to the Amended Map of Chase Plantation, as recorded in Map Book 8, Page 79, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject To:
Ad valorem taxes for 2021 and subsequent years not yet due and payable until October 1, 2021.

Existing covenants and restrictions, easements, building lines and limitations of record.

\$199,500.00 of the consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

Mary Nell Wyatt is the surviving grantee of the survivorship deed in Inst. 1993-40700; the other grantee, Charles R. Wyatt, having died on the 31st day of March, 2006.

It is the intention of the grantees herein that title to the property is held jointly with right of survivorship and the joint tenancy shall not be extinguished upon the death of the first grantee to die or the subsequent death of any of the remaining surviving grantees. The joint tenancy with right of survivorship shall continue to remain in full force and effect and upon the subsequent death of any of the then surviving grantees and all of the decedents undivided fractional interest shall continue to pass to the remaining surviving grantees in equal parts until the entire interest in fee simple passes to the last surviving grantee.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the tract or parcel of land above described together with all and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, appurtenances, and improvements unto the said GRANTEES, for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor, forever.

AND SAID GRANTOR, for said GRANTOR, GRANTOR'S heirs, successors, executors and administrators, covenants with GRANTEES, and with GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, that GRANTOR is lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Real Estate; that said Real Estate is free and clear from all Liens and Encumbrances, except as hereinabove set forth, and except for taxes due for the current and subsequent years, and except for any Restrictions pertaining to the Real Estate of record in the Probate Office of said County; that GRANTOR has a good right to sell and convey the said Real Estate; and that GRANTOR will, and GRANTOR'S heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to said GRANTEES, and GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.

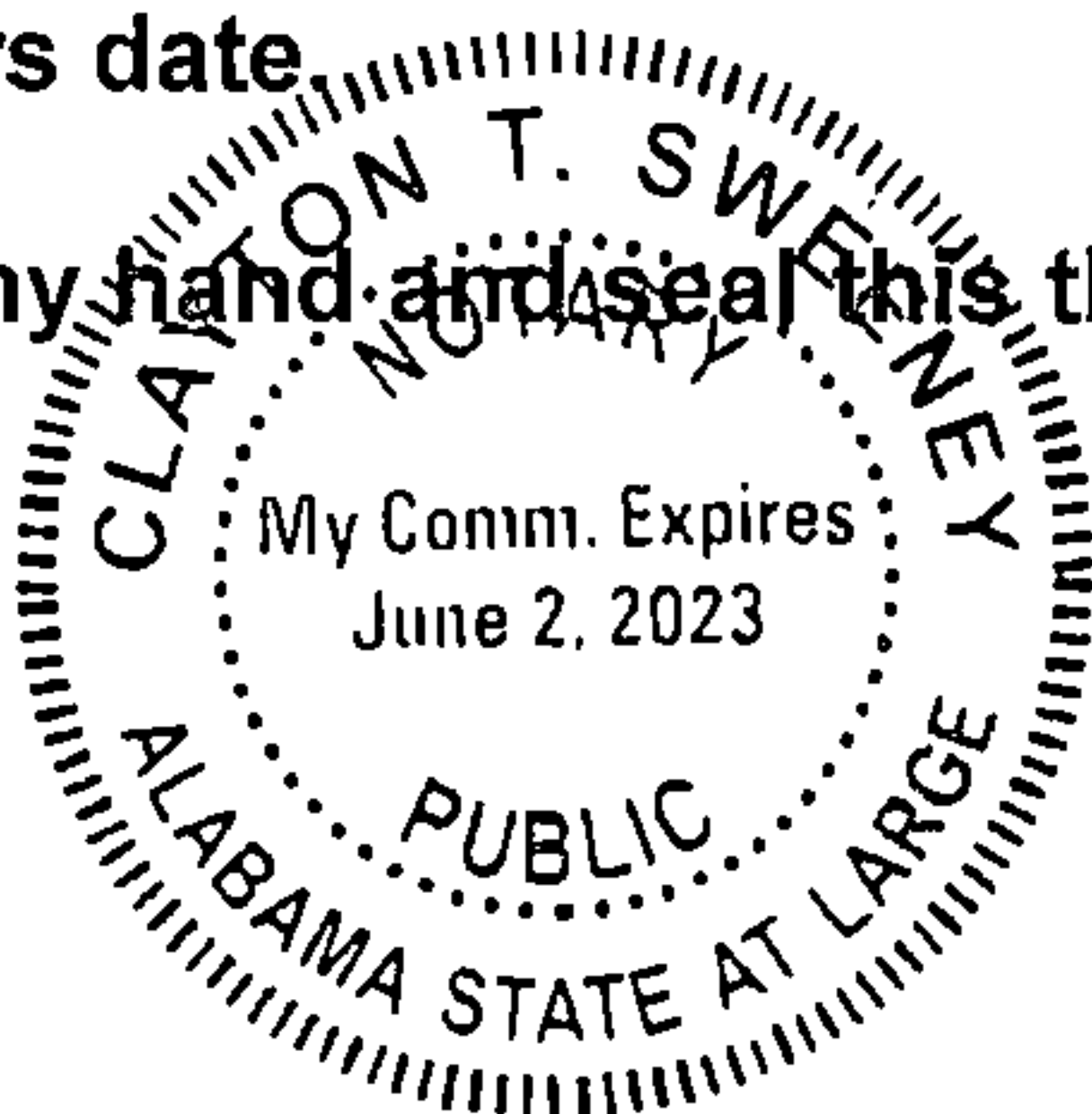
