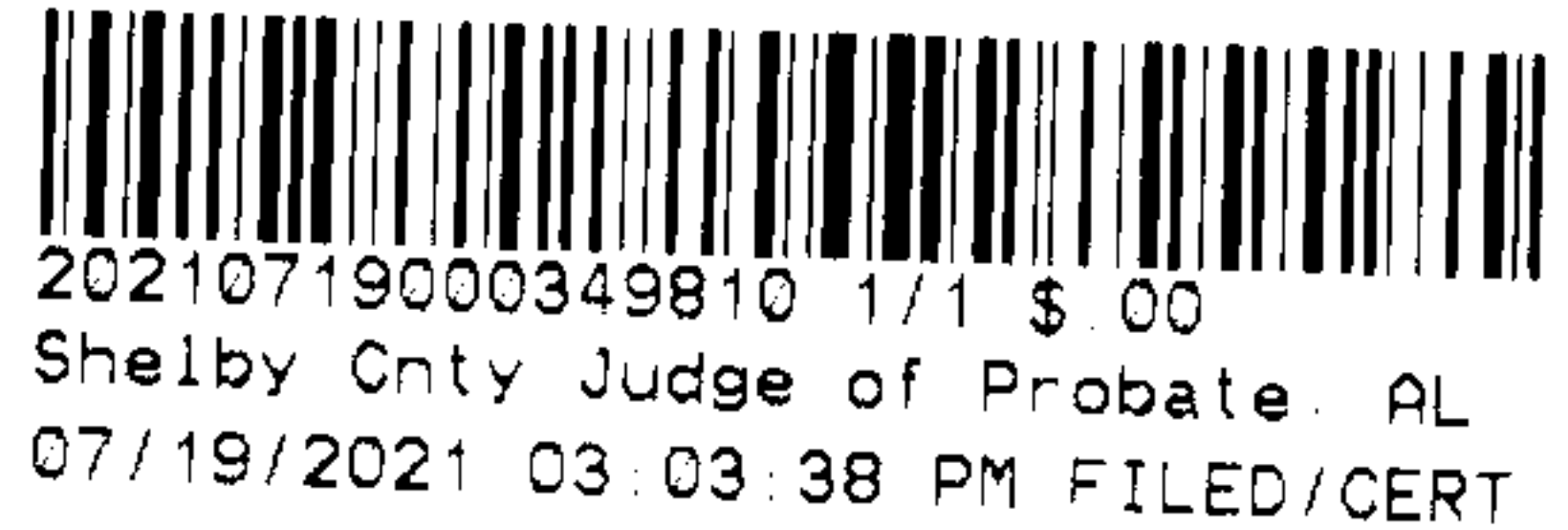

All powers and duties conferred under **Ala. Code, §26-2A-108 (1975)** and as otherwise authorized by law as the lawful Guardian of the said Ward. Said Co-Guardians may act alone or together in their capacity as Co-Guardians with respect to all matters, including, without limitation, to make medical decisions and to sign authorizations for medical care and treatment.

All powers and duties conferred under **Ala. Code, §26-2A-152 (1975)** and as otherwise authorized by law as the lawful Conservator of the said Ward.
