

**CERTIFICATION OF TRUST

 - B. James L. Keating and Suzanne B. Keating, co-trustees can execute documents individually without prior approval or consent from the other trustee.

7. Third parties are entitled to rely on the authority of the successor trustee(s) without proof of his/her/their succession.


