
IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF: **Cecilia A. Moorefield**, an alleged incapacitated person in need of protection

Restricted Temporary Letters of Conservatorship over the Estate of Cecelia A. Moorefield are hereby granted to **Tracy Brown** who has duly qualified \$20,000.00 in accordance with law. Said Temporary Conservator is granted those powers and duties as set forth in Ala. Code, § Section 26-2A-152 (1975 as amended), except the following limitations:

The Temporary Conservator is conferred the limited power and legal authority to do the following acts: to preserve and protect the property of the incapacitated person; to list the real property of Cecilia A. Moorefield with a realtor; to engage the services of an auction company or estate "liquidation company" to schedule a sale of the personal property on the premises of the home of Cecilia A. Moorefield; to inventory, remove and store items of personal property from the home for safekeeping, so long as said items do not exceed the amount of the bond posted in this matter.

The Temporary Conservator shall not hold assets or funds in excess of the bond posted. Any funds due to the estate shall be paid directly to the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama to be held in its fiduciary account.
