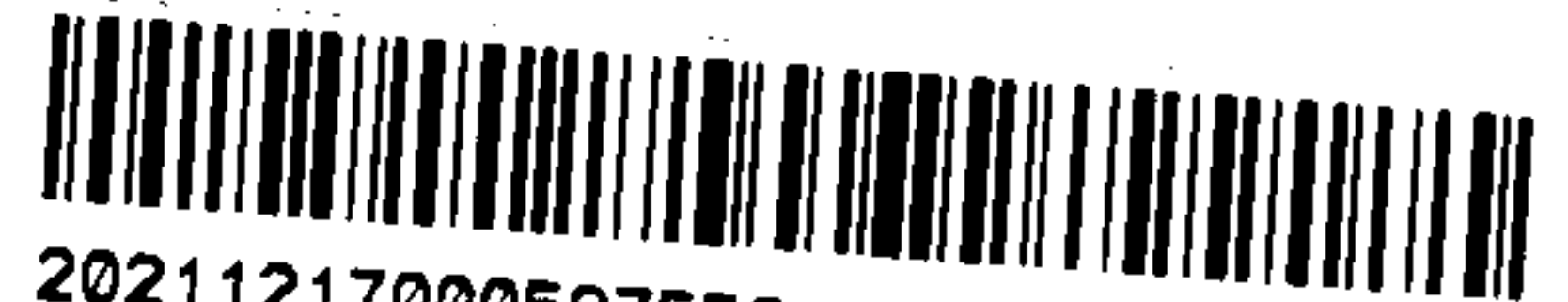

LETTERS OF CONSERVATORSHIP

Alabama Uniform Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Act

Letters of Conservatorship over the estate of LUCILLE WARREN are hereby granted to **DANIEL WARREN** who duly qualified and gave bond in the amount of \$11,500.00 as such Conservator(s) in accordance with law. Said Conservator(s) is/are granted those powers and duties as set forth in **Ala. Code §26-2A-152 (1975, as amended)** except the following limitations:

Conservator is limited to receiving the bond amount. No other funds or assets shall be paid to Conservator without the posting of additional bond and further order of this Court. All remaining funds shall be paid directly to the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama to be held in its fiduciary account.
