

## MINUTES OF THE SHELBY COUNTY JUDICIAL COMMISSION NOMINATING COMMITTEE


The Shelby County Judicial Commission Nominating Committee met on Wednesday, February 15, 2017, at the offices of Boardman, Carr, Petelos, Watkins & Ogle, P.C., in Chelsea, Alabama, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The meeting was called to order by Shelby County Bar President Theresa Terrebonne. Present were Shelby County Bar Secretary Jarred Welborn, Shelby County Bar Treasurer Trey Woodrow, Committee Member Randall May (whose term ends in 2017), Committee Member W. Barry Alvis (whose term ends in 2018), and Committee Member Mark Boardman (whose term ends in 2019). Shelby County Bar Vice-President Patrick Kennedy attended via telephone but was not allowed to vote. The purpose of the meeting was to nominate candidates for member of the Shelby County Judicial Commission.

On motion duly made and properly seconded, the Committee voted to nominate Shelby County Bar Member Margaret Casey for the term ending in 2022, thus filling the position the term of which expired in January 2016 and Shelby County Bar Member William V. 


