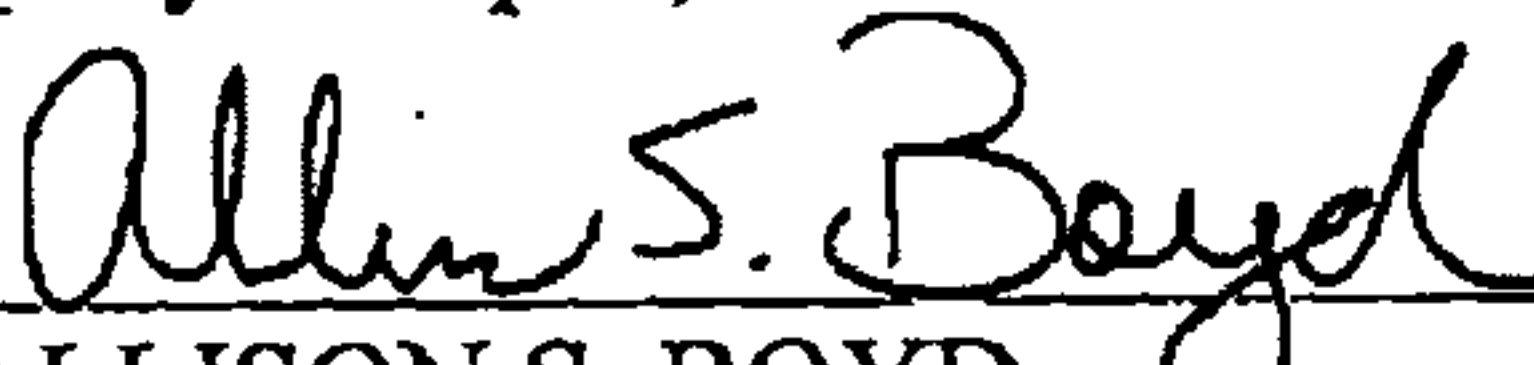
IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF: **Christopher Michael Kelley**, an alleged incapacitated person
in need of protection

Restricted Temporary Letters of Conservatorship over the Estate of **Christopher Michael Kelley** are hereby granted to **Kari Kelley** who has duly qualified \$20,000.00 in accordance with law. Said Temporary Conservator is granted those powers and duties as set forth in Ala. Code, § Section 26-2A-152 (1975 as amended), except the following limitations:

Temporary Conservator is limited to receiving the posted bond amount. No other funds or assets shall be paid to Conservator without the posting of additional bond and further order of this Court. All remaining funds shall be paid directly to the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama to be held in its fiduciary account.

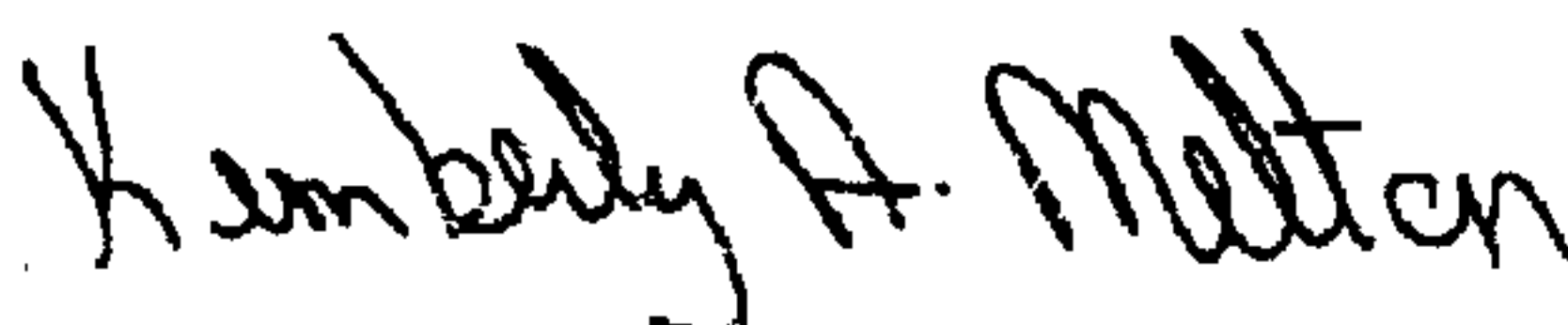
Conferred the limited power and legal authority to do the following acts: to access financial accounts and records for the purpose of preparing an Inventory of the assets of Christopher Michael Kelley and to utilize the assets of Christopher Michael Kelley to pay the mortgage on his home, any monthly utility or service bill in his name, insurance on his automobiles, and any other obligation that nonpayment would result in the loss of the asset if not paid prior to the final hearing.
