KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of **SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$790,000.00) DOLLARS**, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned GRANTORS, **Robert H. Drum, and spouse, Millie Kay Drum** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **David Clark, Julie Clark and Victor Clark** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of **Shelby**, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 10, according to the Survey of Heatherwood, 4th Sector, 2nd Addition, as recorded in Map Book 12, Page 79, 80 and 81, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to existing easements, current taxes, restrictions, set-back lines and rights of way, if any, of record.

\$0.00 of the above-recited purchase price was paid from a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herein.

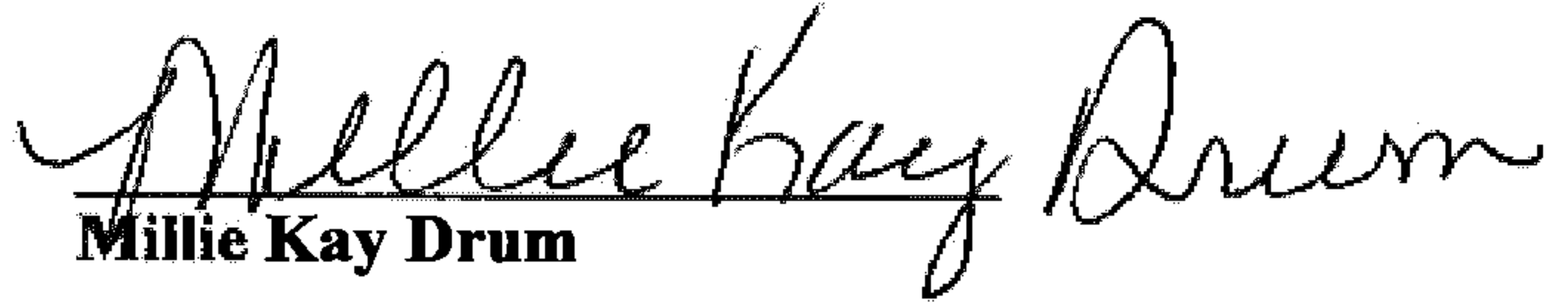
