

- 1. There is a valid and existing trust, having been created by the Robert J. & Audrey Hains Revocable Living Trust under agreement dated March 20, 2019.
- 2. A. The original settlor(s) and successor settlor(s), if any, of the trust was/were:

 - B. The following person(s) contributed money, funds, real property, or personal property to the trust:

 - C. The original settlor(s), Robert J. Hains died on February 11, 2022; the other settlor, Audrey A. Hains is alive and well.
 - D. The original trustees were Robert J. Hains and Audrey A. Hains. Robert J. Hains died on February 11, 2022. The other trustee, Audrey A. Hains, resigned in March of 2022, naming William R. Hains, as the successor trustee.
 - E. The name and address of the currently acting trustee:

 - F. The Robert J. & Audrey A. Hains Revocable Living Trust dated March 20, 2019 has definite beneficiaries. The named beneficiaries are not the sole trustee and sole beneficiary.
 - G. The tax identification number of the trust is intentionally omitted for privacy reasons.



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- Excerpts from the trust document that establish the trust, designate the Trustees, and forth the powers of the trustees, which will be provided upon request. The powers granted to the trustee(s) in Article VIII of our Trust Agreement, include the power to acquire, sell, convey, purchase, exchange, mortgage, pledge, lease, borrow, manage, enter into contracts, deliver deeds, make loans, and otherwise deal with interests in real and personal property in our Trust name. Our Trustees shall have full banking powers, including the power to open, close or modify accounts or other banking arrangements, including, but not limited to, safe deposit boxes, savings, checking, and CD accounts. Our Trustees shall the power to buy, sell, and trade in securities of any nature, including options, futures contracts, short sales, and for such purposes, may maintain, and operate margin accounts with brokers, and may pledge any securities held or purchased by our Trustee with such brokers as security for loans and advances made to our Trustees.
- Trust Property should be titled as follows: William R. Hains, the Successor Trustee of the Robert J. & Audrey A. Hains Revocable Living Trust dated March 20, 2019.
- The Robert J. & Audrey A. Hains Revocable Living Trust dated March 20, 2019, is one and the same as the Robert J. & Audrey A. Hains Revocable Trust dated March 20, 2019, as the Grantee in that certain Quitclaim deed recorded in Instrument No. 20220325000122140, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.
- 6. An alternate description will be effective to title assets in the name of the trust or to designate the trust as a beneficiary if the description includes the name of at least one initial or successor Trustee, any reference indicating that property is being held in a fiduciary capacity, and the date of the trust.
- Our Trust is irrevocable pursuant to the terms of **Article X**, **Amendment and Revocation**; The last sentence of which reads "Upon the death of the first of use to die, the terms of this trust shall become irrevocable. To the best of the undersigned's knowledge, the trust currently exists and has not been revoked, modified or amended in any manner that would cause the representations and statements contained herein to be incorrect. There have been no amendments limiting the powers of our Trustees over trust property.
- 8. No person or entity paying money to or delivering property to my Trustee shall be required to see its application. All persons relying on this document regarding the Trustee and his powers over trust property shall be held harmless for any resulting loss or liability from such reliance. A Copy of this Certificate of Trust shall be just as valid as the original.
