KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That in consideration of **Two Hundred Sixty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$260,000.00)** and other good and valuable consideration, to the undersigned grantor, in hand paid by the grantees herein, the receipt where is acknowledged I, **Patricia A. McGraw, an unmarried person** (herein referred to as grantor), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Chad E. Underwood and Sydney B. Underwood** (herein referred to as grantee) for and during their joint lives, and upon death of any of them, then to the survivor(s) of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in **Shelby County, Alabama**, to wit:

Lot 3, Block 3, according to the Survey of Oak Mountain Estates, as recorded in Map Book 5, page 57, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.


For Ad Valorem tax purposes only, this property is known as 508 Creekview Drive, Pelham, AL 35124.

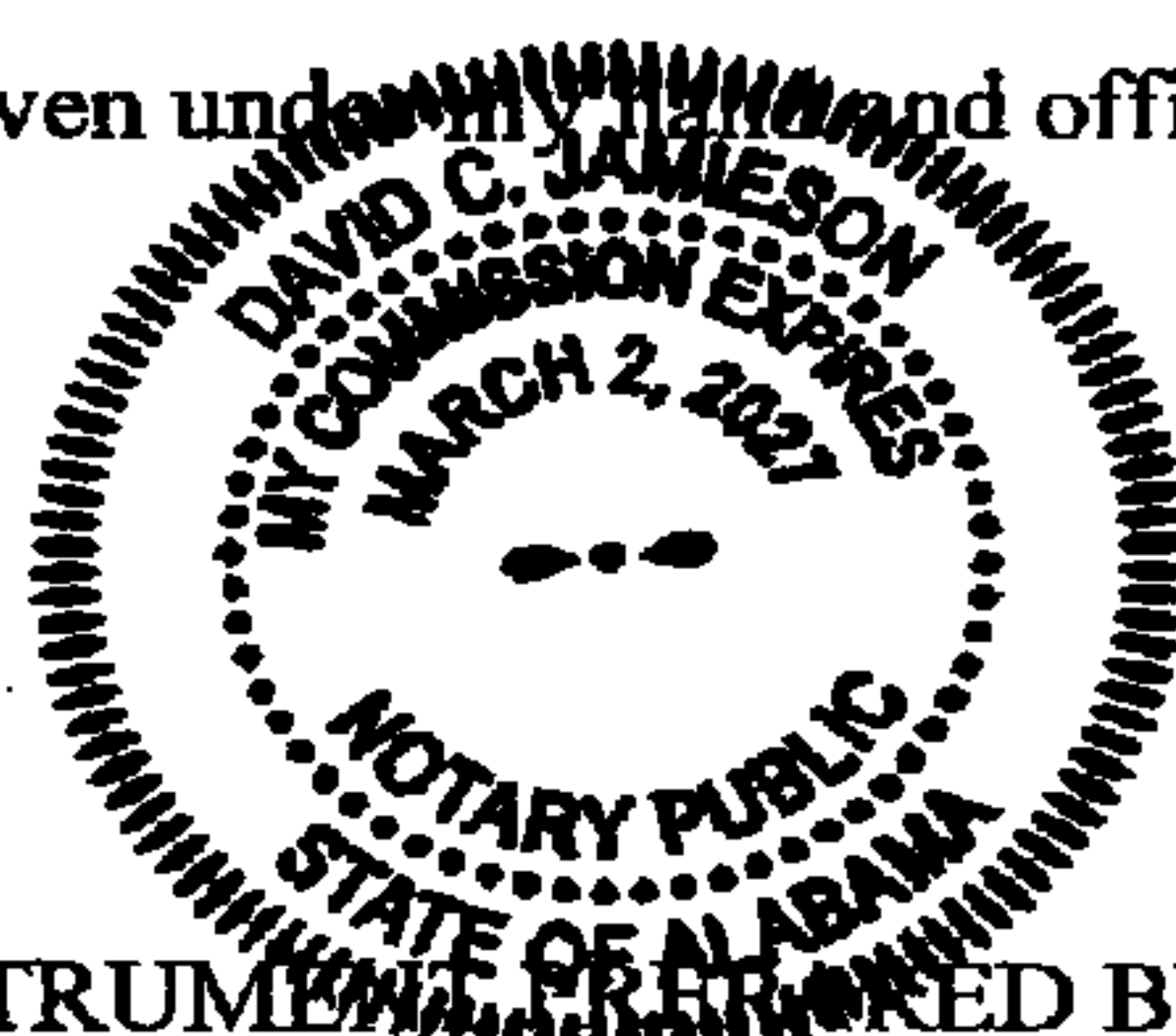
