To make and sign in my name any and all tax or other returns to the State or Federal Government or other taxing authority, to request extensions in connection with such taxes, to protest in my name any such taxes for the proposed assessment of any such taxes, to file claims for refunds of taxes, to make appearances in court or before any taxing authority, either in person or through an attorney-in-fact, to attempt to sustain any tax return or to opposed proposed tax assessments;

To prepare and execute any form, application, report, or instrument for any government or agency of government;

To make insurance claims on my behalf;

To obtain titles or licenses for any motor vehicle (including any mobile home, trailer, or boat owned by me);

To deal with, repair, remodel, lease, mortgage, or sell any real estate owned by me, including any residence, rental property or other investment property, and including the right to collect funds in payment of the same and to release any mortgage or lien thereon;

To deal with, dispose of, sell, or buy any personal property in my name or on my behalf;

To make health care decisions for me if and when I am unable to make my own health care decisions including the power to consent to giving, withholding or stopping any health care, treatment, service or diagnostic procedure and to talk with health care personnel, get information, and sign necessary forms necessary to carry out those decisions;

To make gifts of any of my assets to any individuals (and/or to any charities) provided that I have previously made gifts to such donee, or such donee is a beneficiary under my most recently executed will and any existing trust agreement, or such donee is otherwise a natural object of my bounty, and provided further that fits to my attorney-in-fact may only be made if substantially identical gifts are simultaneously made to others similarly situated; and to consent to transfers being treated as "split gifts" as allowed by law;

To buy, sell, pledge, and otherwise deal with stock, bonds, indentures or any other interest in corporations, businesses, partnerships, or business entities and to execute any right I might have to vote my interest or ownership in the same or participate as officer, director, partner, or otherwise in management of such business entities; and

To otherwise do all things the same as I could myself.

The rights, powers, and authority of my attorney in fact to exercise any and all of the rights and powers herein granted shall commence and be in full force and effect on March 3, 2008, and such rights, powers, and authority shall remain in full force and effect until revoked by me by written notice given and received by RICKY S. HAISLP.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by my disability, incapacity or adjudged incompetency nor by the lapse of time, and it shall be governed by Ohio law.

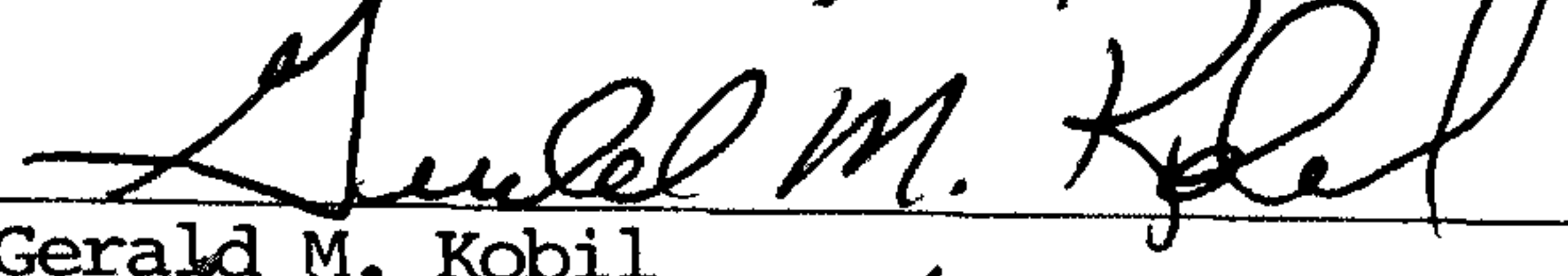

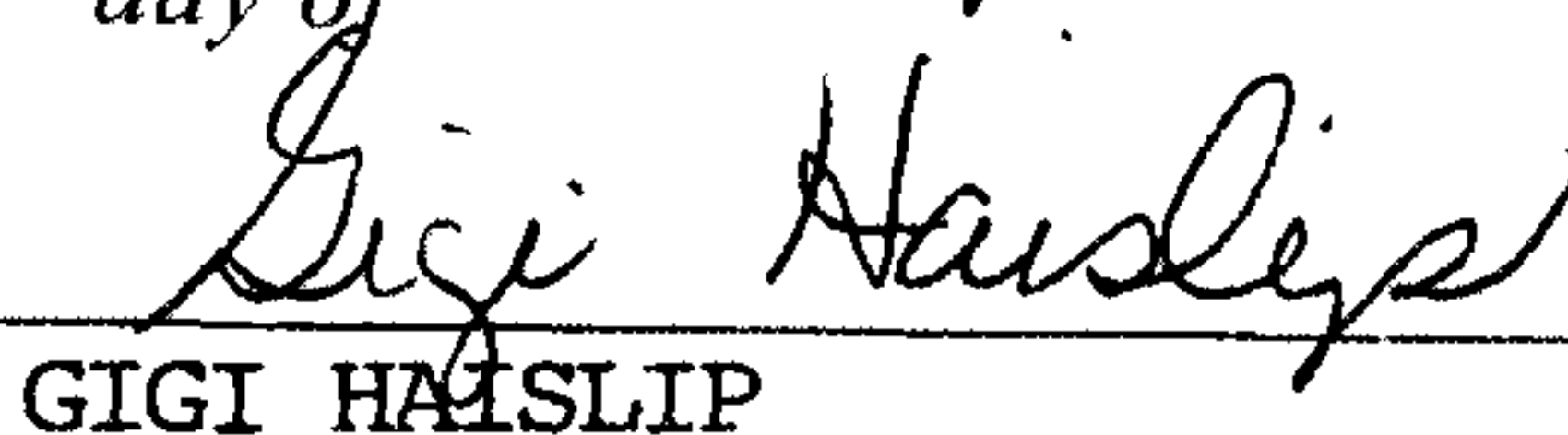
This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability of the principal.

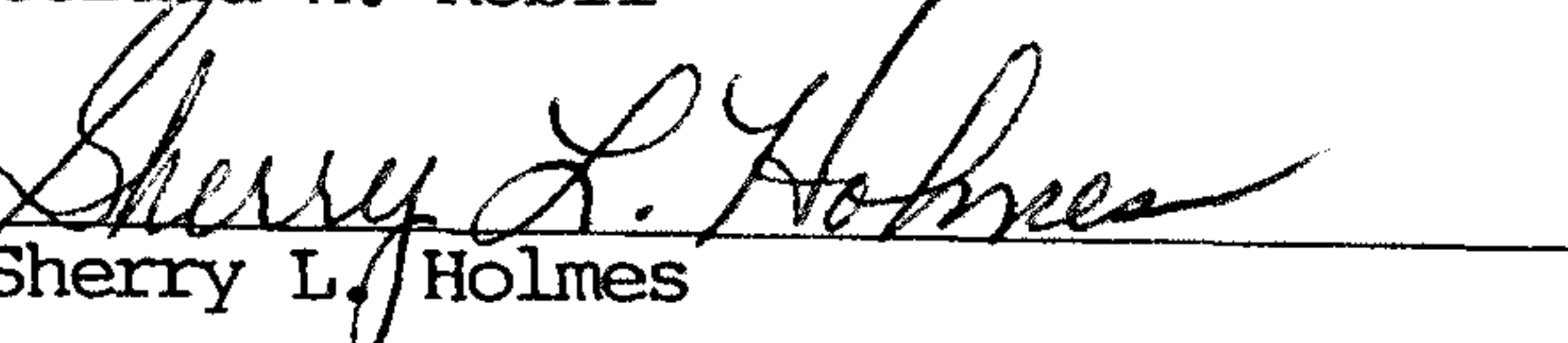

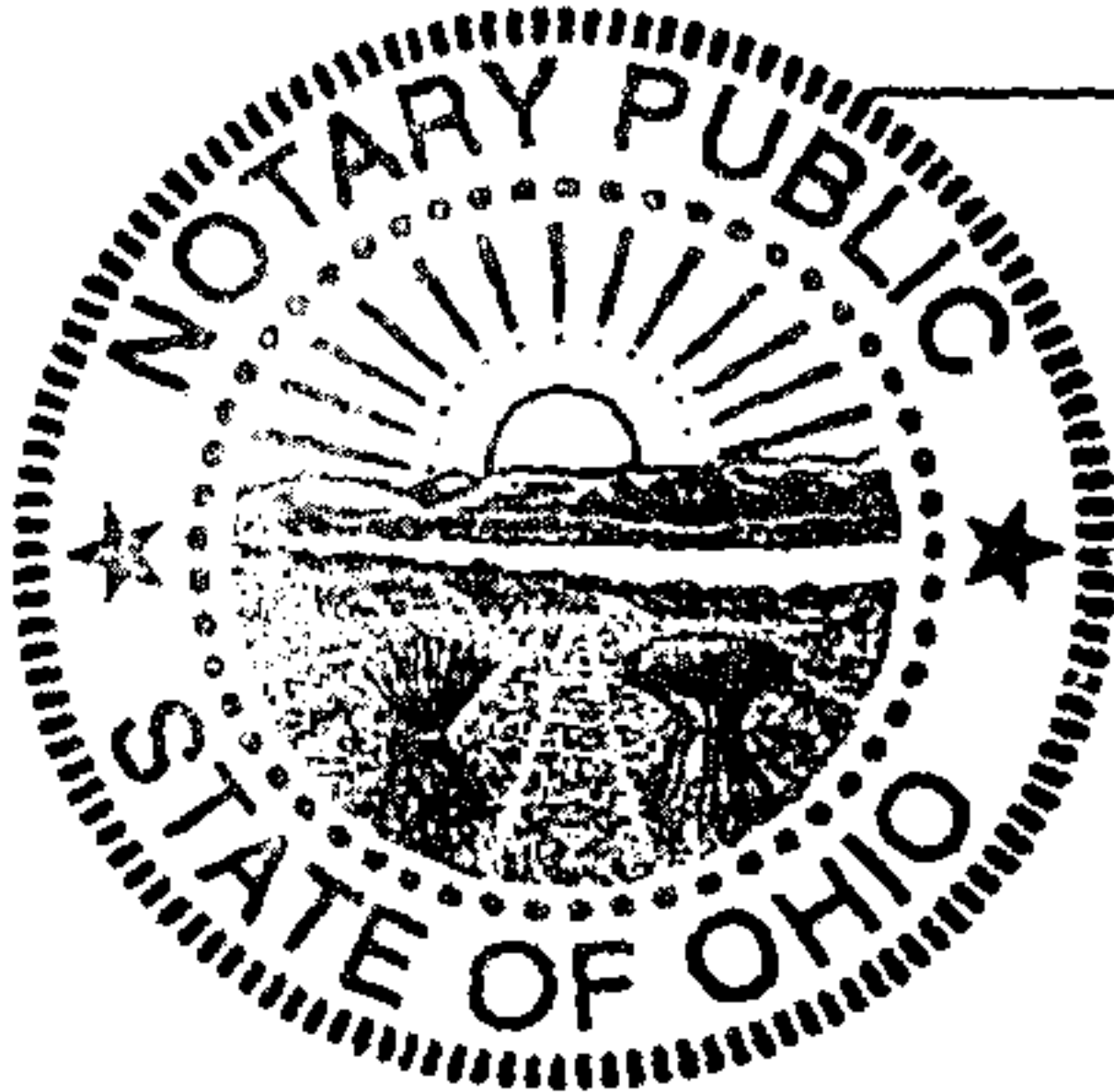
