Plaintiffs have held color of title to defendant for more than ten years and have paid taxes levied against defendant for more than ten years. No other person has paid taxes levied against the defendant.

Plaintiff, Barbara Basemore Moore, is one of the heirs of Eveline Wilson Cross. Moore has a one-quarter (25%) undivided fee simple interest in the defendant.

Plaintiff, Bessie Hill Jackson, is one of the heirs of Eveline Wilson Cross.

Jackson has a one-half (50%) undivided fee simple interest in the defendant.

Plaintiffs Robert Basemore, Ramona Basemore, Vincent Basemore, Ralph Basemore, and Diana Basemore (collectively "the children of Roscoe Basemore, Jr.") are heirs of Eveline Wilson Cross and have a collective one-quarter (25%) undivided fee simple interest in the defendant. Individually, the children of Roscoe Basemore, Jr. each have a one-fifth (.05%) undivided interest in the defendant.
