APPROVING PETITION TO VACATE PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, the vacation of the above-described public street, and all public rights and easements therein, will not deprive the owners of abutting property or other property owners of any right they may have to convenient and reasonable means of ingress and egress to and from their property, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Vincent, Alabama, that the public street described above be and the same is hereby vacated and annulled and all public rights and liabilities therein, including any rights which may have been acquired by prescription, are hereby divested; subject, however, to all existing rights of way or easements for public utilities and to all utility facilities presently situated in said roads vacated hereby. A certified copy of this resolution shall be filed in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and notice of the adoption of this resolution shall be published once in the newspaper in Shelby County no later than 14 days after its adoption.
