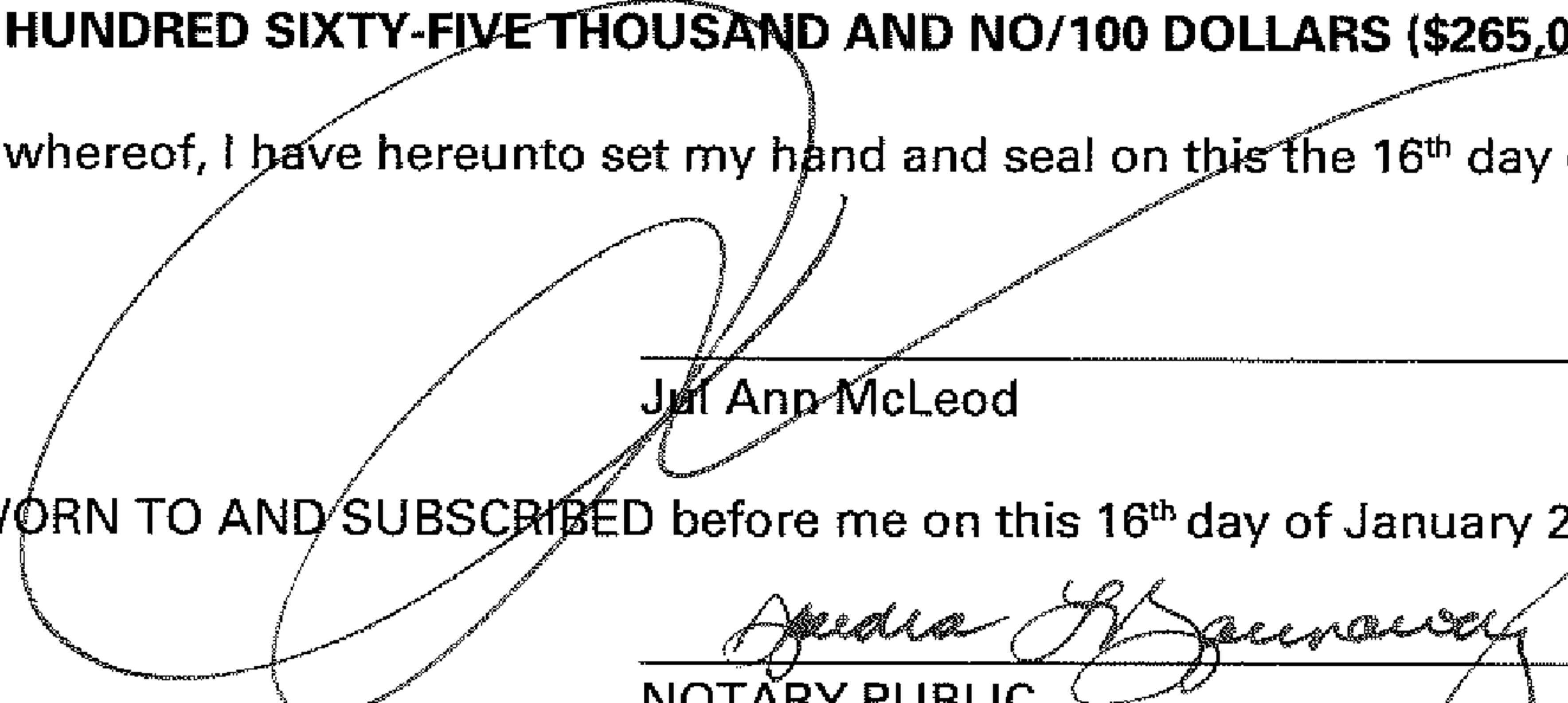
My name is Jul Ann McLeod, and I am a practicing attorney in the City of Hoover, Jefferson County, Alabama.

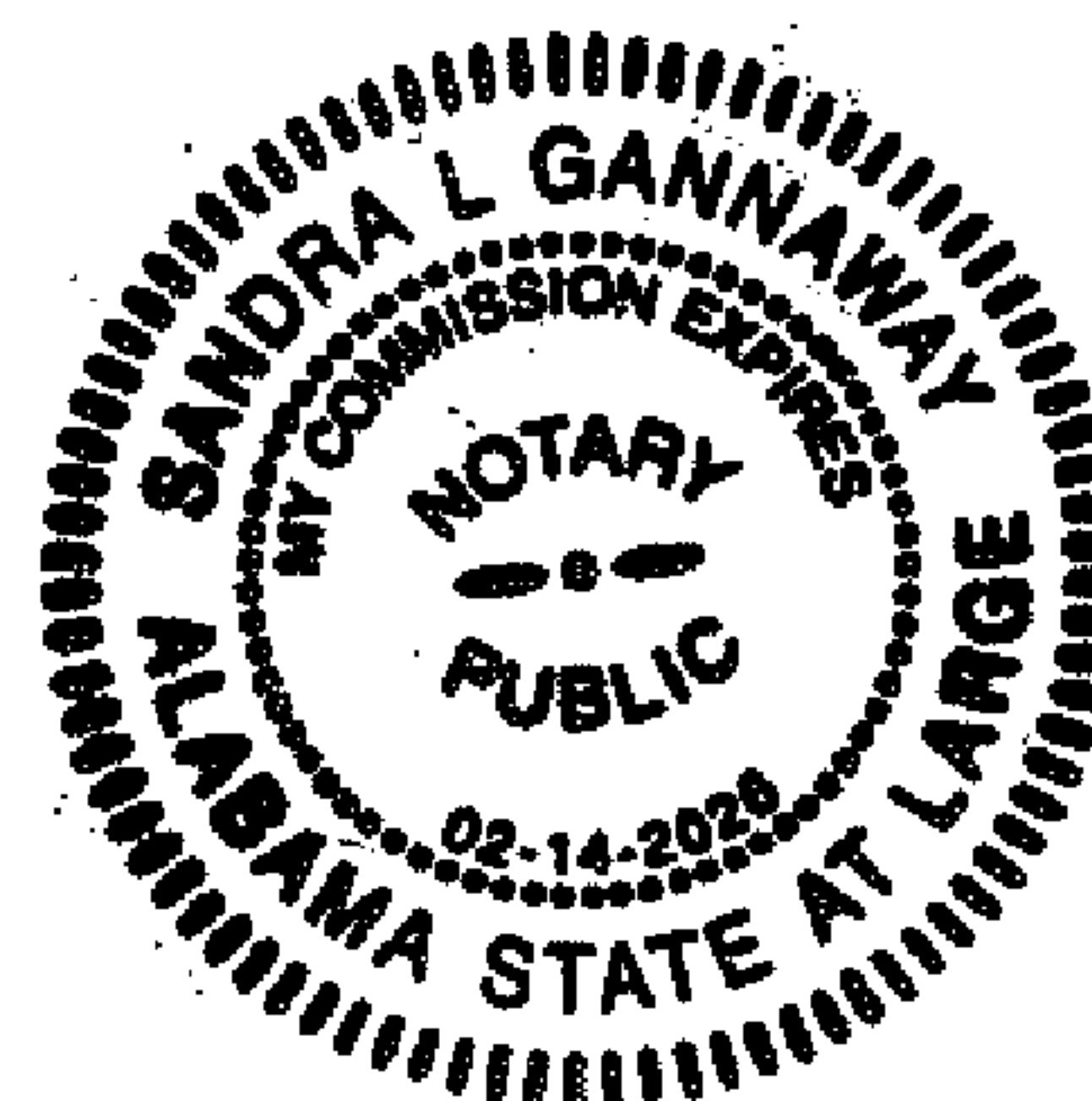
