

**GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY**

**DORIS PERRY WEBSTER**

**For Financial and Other Matters**

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This power of attorney is intended to be in accordance with the provisions of the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act, Code of Alabama § 26-1A-101 *et seq.* This power of attorney authorizes another person (your agent) to make decisions concerning your property for you (the principal). Your agent will be able to make decisions and act with respect to your property (including your money) whether or not you are able to act for yourself. The meaning of authority over subjects listed on this form is explained in the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act, Chapter 1A, Title 26, Code of Alabama 1975. This power of attorney does not authorize the agent to make health care decisions for you. Such powers are governed by other applicable law.

You should select someone you trust to serve as your agent. Unless you specify otherwise, generally the agent's authority will continue until you die or revoke the power of attorney or the agent resigns or is unable to act for you. Your agents are entitled to reimbursement of reasonable expenses and reasonable compensation unless you state otherwise in the Special Instructions. This form provides for a designation for two co-Agents. Co-agents are not required to act together unless you include that requirement in the Special Instructions (which has not been done in this form). If you have any questions about this provision, notify the attorney who drafted this instrument. If your co-Agents are both unable or unwilling to act for you, your power of attorney will end unless you have named a successor agent. You may also name a second successor agent. This power of attorney becomes effective immediately unless stated otherwise in the Special Instructions.

If you have questions about the power of attorney or the authority you are granting to your agent, you should seek legal advice before signing this form.



**B. Grant of General Authority.**

I grant my co-Agents and any Successor Agent general authority to act for me with respect to the following subjects as defined in the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act, Chapter 1A, Title 26, Code of Alabama 1975:

1. Real Property as defined in Section 26-1A-204;
2. Tangible Personal Property as defined in Section 26-1A-205;
3. Stocks and Bonds as defined in Section 26-1A-206;
4. Commodities and Options as defined in Section 26-1A-207;
5. Banks and Other Financial Institutions as defined in Section 26-1A-208;
6. Operation of Entity or Business as defined in Section 26-1A-209;
7. Insurance and Annuities as defined in Section 26-1A-210;
8. Estates, Trusts, and Other Beneficial Interests as defined in Section 26-1A-211;
9. Claims and Litigation as defined in Section 26-1A-212;
10. Personal and Family Maintenance as defined in Section 26-1A-213;
11. Benefits from Governmental Programs or Civil or Military Service as defined in Section 26-1A-214;
12. Retirement Plans as defined in Section 26-1A-215;
13. Taxes as defined in Section 26-1A-216; and
14. Gifts as defined in Section 26-1A-217.

**C. Grant of Specific Authority.**

My co-Agents MAY NOT do any of the following specific acts for me UNLESS I have INITIALED the specific authority listed below:

- DPW Create, amend, revoke, or terminate an inter vivos trust, by trust or applicable law;
- DPW Make a gift to which exceeds the monetary limitations of Section 26-1A-217 of the Alabama Uniform Power of Attorney Act, but subject to any special instructions in this power of attorney;
- DPW Create or change rights of survivorship;
- DPW Create or change a beneficiary designation;
- DPW Authorize another person to exercise the authority granted under this power of attorney;
- DPW Waive the principal's right to be a beneficiary of a joint and survivor annuity, including a survivor benefit under a retirement plan; or
- DPW Exercise fiduciary powers that the principal has authority to delegate.

**D. Limitations on Agent's Authority.**

An agent that is not my ancestor, spouse, or descendant MAY NOT use my property to benefit the agent or a person to whom the agent owes an obligation of support unless I have included that authority in the Special Instructions.

1. Limitation of Power. Except for any special instructions given herein to the agent to make gifts, the following shall apply:
  - (a) Any power or authority granted to my Agent herein shall be limited so as to prevent this Power of Attorney from causing any agent to be taxed on my income or from causing my assets to be subject to a "general power of appointment" by my Agent as defined in 26 U.S.C. § 2041 and 26 U.S.C. § 2514 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
  - (b) My Agent shall have no power or authority whatsoever with respect to any policy of insurance owned by me on the life of my Agent, or any trust created by my Agent as to which I am a trustee.

**E. Special Instructions.**

1. I hereby revoke any previously executed general durable power of attorney which principally authorized my agent thereunder to exercise authority over my financial matters.
2. A detailed outline of my Agent's duties and responsibilities are set forth in Ala. Code § 26-1A-301 under the heading "Important Information for Agent". By this instrument, it is my intention that my Agent have and possess all powers and authorities set forth in Ala. Code §§ 26-1A-204 through 26-1A-217, inclusive, and such Code provisions are incorporated herein by this referenced to the same extent and with the same force as if fully set forth herein.
3. While two or more co-Agents are acting, the following provisions shall apply where the context admits:
  - a. with respect to any matter as to which two or more Agents shall have joint authority an Agent, by written notice, may temporarily delegate any or all of that Agent's rights, powers, duties, and discretion as Agent to any other Agent sharing that authority, with the consent of the latter;
  - b. the Agents may establish bank and brokerage accounts and may authorize that checks or drafts may be drawn on, or withdrawal made from, any such account on the individual signature of any Agent;
  - c. the Agents may execute documents by jointly signing one document or separately signing concurrent counterpart documents.
  - d. in the event that any Agent then serving hereunder is or becomes unable or unwilling to serve, and if no successor is named herein for such Agent, then the remaining Agent or Agents then serving shall have full power and authority to act without the necessity for the appointment of a successor.
  - e. At any time when more than one Agent is serving hereunder, my co-agents shall each have the separate and independent authority to take any actions authorized hereunder. Each Agent, having the power to act independently of the other, may take any action authorized under this Instrument without the knowledge or consent of any co-Agent. Any third party may rely on the consent or approval of any Agent without contacting or seeking the approval of any other co-Agent.
  - f. In the event that my Agents disagree on any action proposed to be undertaken, then the action shall not be undertaken until such time and unless they shall agree. Any third party having actual notice of such disagreement shall not be entitled to rely on one Agent's

direction to undertake such action, provided that this paragraph shall not apply to any third party not provided with actual written notice of the disagreement.

**F. Effective Date.**

This power of attorney is effective immediately unless I have stated otherwise in the Special Instructions.


**G. Nomination of Conservator or Guardian.**

Any person, including my co-Agent, may rely upon the validity of this power of attorney or a copy of it unless that person knows it has terminated or is invalid.



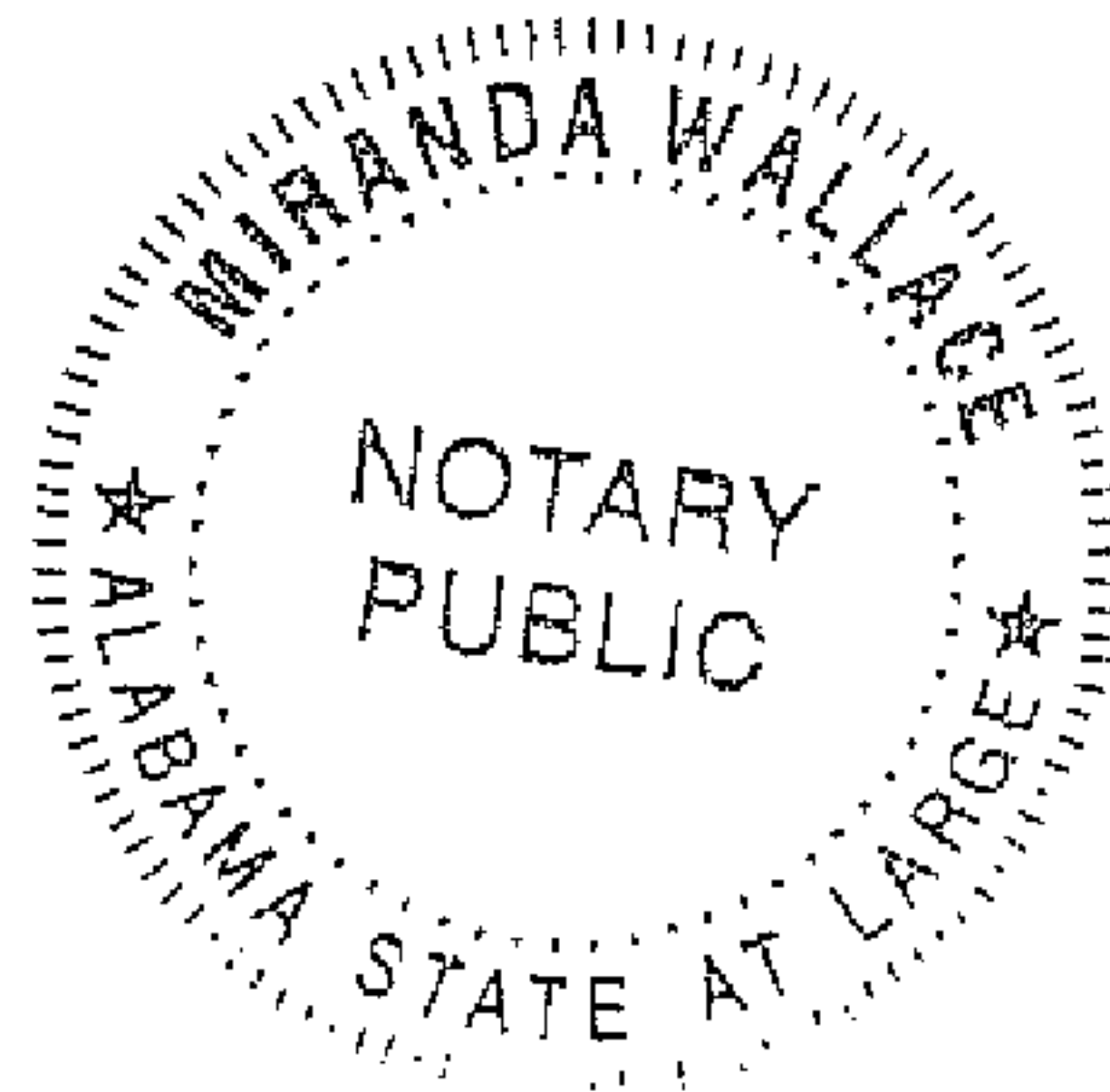
