This cause having been presented to the Court upon the Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, and the Court having considered the pleadings filed in this case and upon further

Consideration of the verified Complaint and the reports filed in this case, the Court makes the following findings of fact:

1. That at the time of the filing of the Complaint, Plaintiff claimed in his own right the fee simple title to, and was in actual possession of, the following described lands:

- 3. That Plaintiff's Complaint was filed against said lands and against Troyce Brunson, Brandon Brunson any and all persons claiming any title to, interest in, lien or encumbrance on said lands or any part thereof, and was to establish the right or title to such lands or interest, and to clear up all doubts or disputes concerning the same, and that said Complaint did in all respects comply with the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, 6-6-561 and 6-6-540 and 6-6-541.

- 4. That service of process was had in strict compliance with Alabama Code Section 6-6-564 and Rule 4.1 Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure, and that Plaintiff's exercised diligence to ascertain all of the facts in regard to the names of proper party defendants.
- 5. That Defendant, Troyce Brunson was served with process by Certified Mail on May 23, 2023. On June 26, 2023, Brandon Brunson was served by process server pursuant to Rule 4.1 Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure.
- 6. That Plaintiff named in the Complaint all Defendants known to Plaintiff after the exercise of diligence.
- 7. That Plaintiff complied with all the provisions of the law relative to this proceeding in rem and in personam to establish title to land.

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

(a) That the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought in the Complaint and that the fee simple title claimed by the Plaintiff in and to the above-described lands has been proven and that the Plaintiff is the owner of
