That in consideration of **SIX HUNDRED NINETY ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND 00/100 Dollars (\$691,500.00)** to the undersigned grantors in hand paid by the grantees herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, we,

A. M. Bradley and D. L. Bradley, wife and husband

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantors") do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

Walter Edmunds Patterson, III and Martha Iles Patterson

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantees"), as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Lot 706, according to the Survey of Riverchase Country Club 7th Addition, as recorded in Map Book 8, Page 176, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama

- Subject to:

 - (3) all easements, rights-of-way, restrictions, covenants and encumbrances of record.

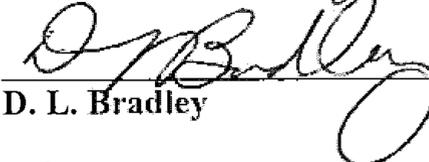

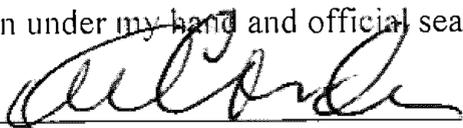

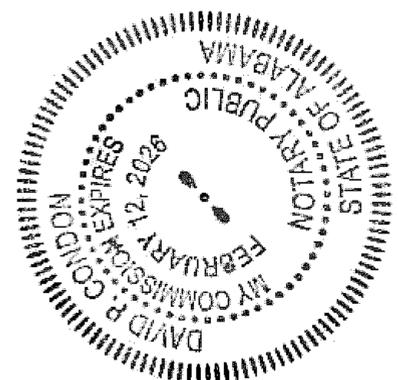
