### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, **William Frank Setzer**, the principal herein, a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, do make, constitute and appoint my daughter, **Shelby Setzer**, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, but in the event she should predecease me or is unwilling to serve, I do make, constitute and appoint her Mother, **Candy Cable**, as my alternate attorney-in-fact, subject to the following terms and conditions:

**FIRST:** This power of attorney shall not be affected by subsequent disability or incapacity. All acts done by my attorney-in-fact during any period of disability or incapacity shall have the effect and inure to the benefit of and bind me and my successor in interest as if I were competent and not disabled.

**SECOND:** I authorize and empower my attorney-in-fact or alternate attorney-in-fact to act for me and in my name, place and stead in the following regards:

1. To receive all dividends, interest and income arising from my property and estate and to receive all monies payable to me.
2. To endorse and negotiate any check or other negotiable paper payable to me.
3. To deposit any and all income or monies so received on my behalf in any of my checking, savings or other investment accounts;
4. To make withdrawals from any savings account or other investment account, to hold and negotiate certificates of deposit and other investment certificates, and to draw checks or drafts against any checking or other draft account;
5. To enter any safe deposit box that I may have, and to place things therein and to remove things therefrom;
6. To expend on my behalf all monies or funds belonging to me;
7. To sell, transfer, convey and assign any and all real and personal property belonging to me;

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8. To do and act in every respect regarding my person, property, and estate, real, personal and mixed, as fully and completely as I myself could do;

9. To execute any and all papers and documents necessary and incident to fulfill the powers herein granted; and

10. To acquire, maintain, cancel or in any manner deal with any policy of life, accident, disability, hospitalization, medical or casualty insurance, and prosecute each claim for benefits due under any policy.

THIRD: I ratify and confirm all acts that my attorney-in-fact shall do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

FOURTH: If protective proceedings for my person or estate are hereafter commenced, I nominate for consideration by the court any aforementioned attorney-in-fact to be conservator or gaurdian of my person and estate.

FIFTH: This power of attorney is executed pursuant to the provisions of

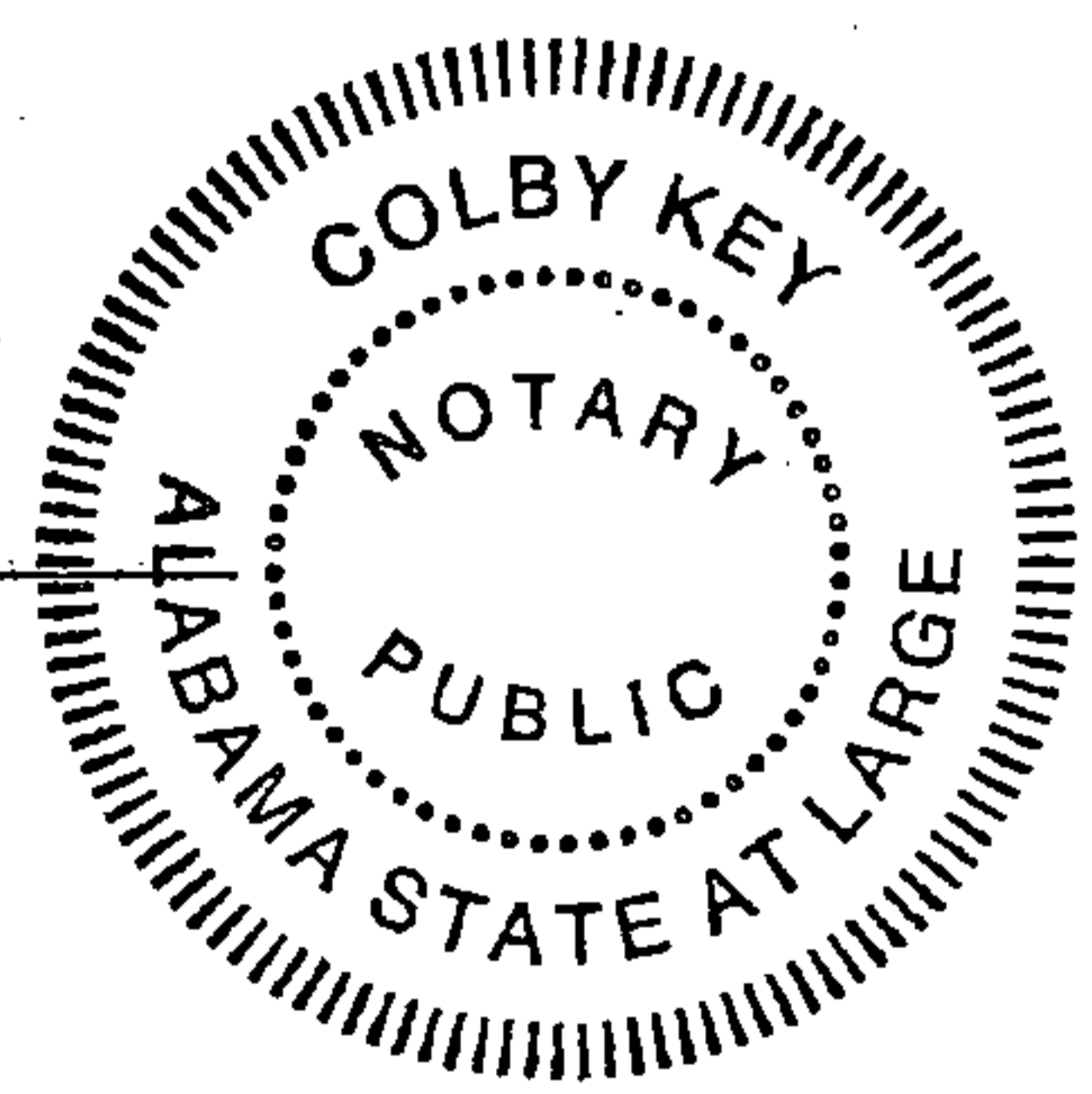
