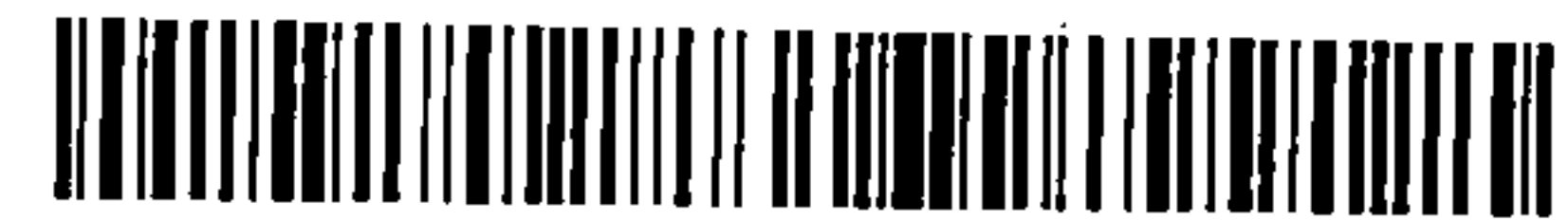

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Judgment by default is entered this date, in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, for the sum of \$3,000.00 plus costs of court, without waiver of exemptions as to personal property, from which let execution issue.
