

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

BEFORE ME, the undersigned Notary Public in and for the aforesaid county and state, in the presence of the witnesses hereinafter named and undersigned, personally came and appeared:

**JOHN HARVEY WATSON, JR.** (XXX-XX-2771) a resident of the City of Hoover, Shelby County, Alabama, with a mailing address 2989 Zilphy Street, Hoover, Alabama 35244 (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Principal"); who declared that Principal hereby makes, constitutes and appoints:

**CHERYL WATSON DUKE**, a resident of the City of Hoover, Shelby County, Alabama, with a mailing address of 2989 Zilphy Street, Hoover, Alabama, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Agent"),

to act as the Principal's true and lawful Agent and attorney-in-fact, without bond, for Principal and in Principal's name, place and stead, to do any and every act and to exercise any and every other power that Principal might or could do or exercise through any other person, including not only all matters of administration, but also all acts of ownership and the doing of whatever may appear to said Agent and attorney-in-fact to be conducive to the interest of Principal, from and after the date of acceptance by her and the execution of the attached "Act Of Acceptance Of Appointment Of Agency." It is expressly provided herein that Principal designates CHERYL WATSON DUKE as Principal's true and lawful Agent and such Agent is fully authorized to act on Principal's behalf without the consent of Principal just as Principal could have done in his own name and for himself.

By execution of this Durable Power of Attorney, I hereby revoke, prospectively from date of recordation of this Durable Power of Attorney, all prior powers of attorney executed by me including specifically that "Durable Power of Attorney of John Harvey Watson, Jr." recorded on August 2, 2024 in the public records of Shelby County, Alabama under Registry No. 20240802000239990 as of the date of filing of this Durable Power of Attorney in the public records of Shelby County, Alabama. I expressly ratify all acts of every nature done by my agent, Cheryl Duke, under that "Durable Power of Attorney of John Harvey Watson, Jr." recorded on August 2, 2024 in the public records of Shelby County, Alabama under Registry No. 20240802000239990 prior to its revocation as set forth hereinabove.

ARTICLE 1

PROPERTY



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"Property" means all of my interests in property, whether movable, immovable, real, personal, corporeal, incorporeal, tangible, intangible or mixed, wherever located, however acquired, whether owned by me now or hereafter acquired by me or on my behalf by my Agent or by third persons.

With regard to Property, my Agent shall:

1.1 General powers. Have all of the powers that may be conferred upon agents under applicable law, If a question should arise as to whether my Agent has a particular power, this agency shall be liberally construed as granting such power, and any headings hereof shall not be construed as limiting any powers granted herein. Should future changes in the law expand the powers of agents, my Agent shall have those expanded powers.

1.2 Additional powers. Without limiting my Agent's powers granted hereinabove, if those powers do not include the following, my Agent shall also have all of the following powers:

1.3 Purchases and sales. To purchase, alienate, sell, convey, assign, exchange, partition or otherwise acquire and dispose of Property, at public or private sale for such purposes and upon such terms, including sales on credit, with or without security, in such manner, and at such prices as my Agent may determine. My Agent may purchase U. S. Government bonds redeemable at par in payment of federal estate taxes. My Agent may invest funds as my Agent may think proper and best.

1.4 Operation of businesses: changes in corporate structure. To operate, in whole or in part, or to participate in the operation of any business or business interest, including partnerships, at any time belonging to me; and to do any and all things which my Agent deems appropriate thereto and which I might do as absolute owner and holder of such business or business interest, including, but without being limited thereto, the right to invest additional capital therein; to incorporate said business in any manner, on any terms and conditions, and for any capitalization, duration or purpose, authorized by the laws applicable thereto; to change the nature of said business or its form of organization; to enlarge or diminish the scope of its activity; to reorganize, to merge, to consolidate, to dissolve or to liquidate it, or to participate in such incorporation, change, reorganization, merger, consolidation, dissolution or liquidation; to participate in any plans involving the above and to participate with any protective committee and to delegate to such committee discretionary powers with relation thereto and to pay a proportionate part of the expenses of such committee and any such assessments levied under such plan; to accept and retain new securities received by my Agent pursuant to any such plan; to exercise all conversion, subscription, voting and other rights of whatsoever nature pertaining to such property; and to pay any amount or amounts of money my Agent may deem advisable.

1.5 Partnerships. To cause my Agent (on my behalf to become a partner in such partnerships as my Agent may see fit, whether as a limited or general partner, or partner in commendam, including the power to form or cause to be formed, or join with any other person or persons in forming or causing to be formed, a partnership or partnerships, in any manner, on any terms and conditions, and for any capitalization, duration or purpose, authorized by the laws applicable thereto; to execute as one of the partners either general or limited (in commendam) articles of partnership; to continue me or my Agent as a partner in any partnership in which I may be a partner or possessed of the right to become a partner; and to consent to the continuation of any partnership that might otherwise terminate even though the articles of partnership may not provide for continuation.

1.6 Options. To grant options affecting Property for such purposes and periods, upon such conditions, in such manner, and at such prices as my Agent may determine; to exercise them for such price and on such terms and conditions as my Agent may see fit.

1.7 Servitudes and easements. To create servitudes or easements on Property for such purposes and periods, upon such conditions, in such manner, and at such price as my Agent may determine.



1.8 Leases. To lease or give options to lease all or any part of the Property for such price, and on such terms and conditions, for such purposes and at such rentals as my Agent may see fit; to enter into, amend or extend all kinds of leases including, but not limited to, all kinds of predial leases, surface leases, and oil, gas and mineral leases, with or without pooling provisions.

Throughout this document, the power to lease includes the power to sublease.

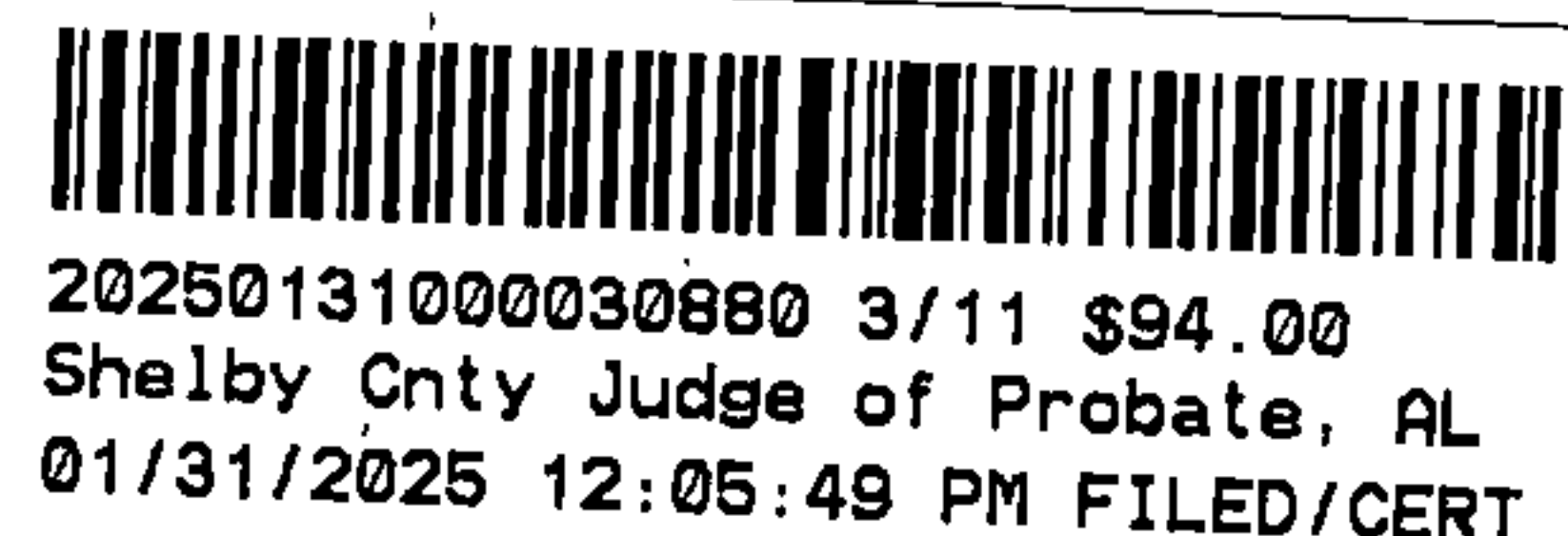
1.9 Oil gas and other minerals. To sell, lease, exchange, partition or otherwise alienate oil, gas or other minerals and interests therein, and the right to explore for them, or options for any of these, by such instruments, in such forms, for such bonuses, rentals or other considerations, and for such terms and periods as my Agent may see fit. To invest in, to acquire and retain for so long a period as my Agent may see fit, oil, gas and mineral leases and rights in and to oil, gas and other minerals either in the form of mineral interests, royalties or other proprietary or working interests, whether productive when acquired or nonproductive when acquired, whether or not speculative in nature, with or without pooling provisions, to explore or to contract for mineral exploration and to drill and to enter into pooling, unitization, repressurization, and any other type of agreement relating to the development, operation and conservation of mineral property.

1.10 Borrowing, etc. To borrow money or otherwise contract loans either unsecured or secured, in such amounts, for such terms, at such rates of interest or without interest, and in such manner as my Agent may think desirable and to secure such indebtedness by mortgage, pawn, or pledge of Property or otherwise, and to mortgage or pledge Property for any period of time my Agent shall think desirable and to acknowledge indebtedness. My Agent may also bind the Principal as surety for any obligation(s), and grant security for said obligation(s).

1.11 Lending, etc. To make loans of Property to such persons, firms, partnerships, corporations, or political subdivision, including businesses or business interest in which my Agent may be personally interested, for such purposes and for such periods, in such amounts and at such rates of interest, with or without security, and subject to such other terms as my Agent may determine. Also to remit debts. My Agent also may make, accept, draw and endorse promissory notes, bills of exchange and other negotiable or non-negotiable instruments in the name of Principal, and bind the Principal by acknowledgment of debt, promise to pay and engagements of all kinds.

1.12 Exchanges. To exchange Property for other property or to give options to exchange Property upon such terms as my Agent may deem advisable.

1.13 Retention of property. To hold and retain Property in the form received so long as my Agent deems advisable, and to purchase and retain securities or other properties, although of a kind or in an amount that would not ordinarily be considered suitable, whether or not such property is productive of income and even though it may not be prescribed or authorized by law.



I .14 Improvements and developments. To raze any buildings or other structures as my Agent may consider expedient; to improve or develop immovable property; to erect, alter, or repair any buildings or other structures and to make any other kind of improvements my Agent may deem proper; to receive, accept, hold, use, control, administer, build upon, manage or otherwise improve, repair, divide or subdivide all or any Property in the manner and to the extent my Agent may deem advisable.

1.15 Agents and employees. To employ or retain such employees, agents and advisors whether natural or artificial persons as my Agent may deem necessary, to assist in performing any duties of my Agent, including, but by way of illustration only, investment advice, management advice, and for any other purposes my Agent considers advisable; to determine reasonable charges for such services and to make payment out of Property; and to terminate employees, agents and advisors.

1.16 Securities mutual funds etc. To acquire, retain for so long a period as my Agent may see fit and sell securities of all kinds, including stock, bonds, and all other types of investment vehicles, including interests or shares of investment companies or investment trusts, whether of the open-end or closed-end type, and without notice to anyone, to participate in any common trust fund or pooled investment fund.

1.17 Life insurance. To insure the life of any other person on whose life I may have an insurable interest. Life insurance shall be in such amounts as my Agent may determine, and in such forms, as my Agent may deem wise by term insurance, ordinary life insurance, stated period payment insurance, endowment insurance or any other kind of life insurance. Proceeds of life insurance shall be made payable to any beneficiary or contingent beneficiary designated by my Agent. My Agent may elect any option provided by any policy. My Agent may surrender any of such policies at any time and obtain the cash surrender value, or may borrow against such value, or may exercise any other right of an owner of the policy.

1.18 Custody and location of property. To keep all or any part of the Property at any place in Louisiana or elsewhere within the United States or abroad with such depositories or custodians at such places as my Agent shall deem necessary or advisable and to have the power to hold securities in the names of nominees.

1.19 Powers of attorney. To give such powers of attorney, general or special, with or without power of substitution, in connection with the exercise of other powers as my Agent may deem advisable.

1.20 Miscellaneous agreements. To enter into any and all kinds of agreements on my behalf, whether or not specifically described in this document, and my Agent may contract with himself or herself.

I .21 Accounts and instruments. To establish accounts of all kinds, (including checking and savings) for me with financial institutions, including banks, thrift institutions, brokerage firms, and credit unions. To modify, terminate, make deposits to and write checks on or make withdrawals from and grant security interests in all accounts in my name or upon which I or my Agent are authorized signatories, whether such account was established by me or for me by my Agent. To contract for any services rendered by any bank or other financial institution. My Agent may execute vouchers in Principal's behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements

properly payable by the United States and receive, endorse and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States. To endorse, transfer, collect and receive the proceeds of any promissory note, draft, check, bill of exchange, or other negotiable or non-negotiable instrument whether in bearer form or made payable to me or to my order and give receipt therefore, and to endorse for deposit in or for collection by any bank or corporate institution, wheresoever situated, promissory notes, drafts, checks, bills of exchange, or negotiable or non-negotiable instrument whether in bearer form or made payable to me or to my order.

1.22 Safe deposit boxes. To contract with any institution for a safe deposit box in my name. To have access to all safe deposit boxes in my name or to which I am an authorized signatory, whether or not the contract for such safe deposit box was executed by me (either alone or jointly with others) or by my Agent in my name. To add to and remove from the contents of any safe deposit box and to terminate contracts for such boxes.

1.23 Legal proceedings. To commence, prosecute, discontinue, supervise, intervene in, arbitrate, refer to arbitration, compromise, settle, confess judgment, or defend all kinds of claims, actions or proceedings concerning or involving me in any way, with full power to waive citation, to accept service, to plead prescription and to apply for writs and all other process, including appeal, including claims by or against me arising out of property damages or personal injuries suffered by or caused by me or under circumstances causing the loss to be borne by me. To accept or reject all successions falling to Principal, and represent the Principal, whether as heir, legatee, creditor, executor, administrator or otherwise, in all successions or estates in which Principal may be or become interested; to apply for the administration thereof, and to demand, obtain and execute all kinds of orders, decrees and judgments in connection therewith; to partition or divide the same in any manner; to accept, settle, compromise, liquidate or renounce my interest therein; to receive and receipt for all property to which I may be entitled in respect of said successions or estates; and to act as agent for service of process in any succession of which I am appointed legal representative;

I .24 Trusts. To execute trust instruments on my behalf as settlor or co-settlor, whether or not I am a beneficiary. To make gifts in trust on my behalf to trusts created by my Agent or to other trusts. To provide that a trust shall be revocable or irrevocable, and interests in the trust spendthrift or freely alienable. To serve as trustee of any other trust created by or for my benefit. To add my assets to any trust and to revoke or terminate any trust on my behalf. To withdraw or receive the income or principal and to request or demand such withdrawals of any trust.

I .25 Fiduciary offices. To renounce any fiduciary office to which I may be appointed or elected, including (but not limited to) executor, administrator, personal representative, trustee, tutor, curator, guardian, attorney-in-fact, or officer or director of a corporation. To render such accountings of my activities as may be required.

1.26 Taxation. To represent me in all tax matters, including federal income, gift, estate and excise taxes. To prepare, execute and file any application, tax return, report, notice, statement, consent, protest, waiver,



petition or agreement or document required or permitted to be filed under any law, ordinance, resolution, rule, regulation or directive of the United States of America, or of any department of, or corporation, board, authority, agency, political subdivision or instrumentality heretofore or hereafter created, designated or established by the United States of America or any state thereof, including joint returns, FICA returns, payroll tax returns, claims for refunds, requests for extensions of time, petitions to the U. S. Tax Court or other courts regarding tax matters, and all other tax-related documents, including consents and agreements under Section 2032A, Internal Revenue Code, consents to split gifts, closing agreements, and any power of attorney form required by the Internal Revenue Service or any state or local taxing authority with respect to any tax year from the year 1975 to the year 2025. To pay taxes due, collect and make such disposition of refunds as my Agent shall deem appropriate; to post bonds, receive confidential information and contest deficiencies determined by the Internal Revenue Service or any other taxing authority. To exercise any elections I may have under federal, state or local tax law; and generally to represent me or obtain professional representation for me in all tax matters and proceedings of all kinds and for any period before any taxing authority. To engage, compensate and discharge attorneys, accountants and other tax and financial advisors and consultants to represent or assist me in connection with any tax matter involving or in any way related to me or any Property in which I have or may have any interest or responsibility.

1.27 Gifts. To make donations, gifts or other gratuitous transfers either outright or in trust, (including the forgiveness of debt and the completion of any charitable pledge) to such persons or organizations as my Agent shall select. Such donations may be gratuitous, onerous or remunerative and may be made to any persons or corporations including charitable institutions and including my Agent or any family members of my Agent.

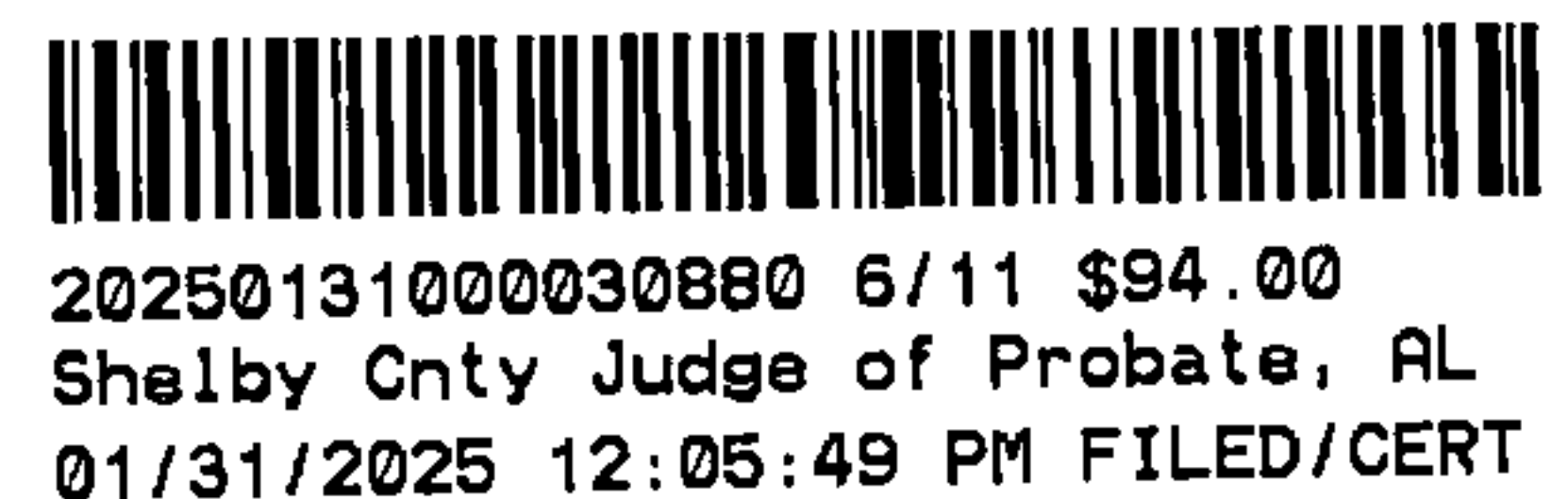
1.28 Support. To continue to support any person I have undertaken to support or to whom I may owe an obligation of support. Support may include payment of real property taxes, payments on loans secured by my residence, maintenance of my residence, food, clothing and shelter, medical, dental and psychiatric care, normal vacations and travel expenses.

1.29 Bonds. To make and execute bonds of all kinds, either as principal or surety, and to make and execute applications therefore.

1.30 Demands. To demand, make allowances in respect to, remit or recover and receive anything due or belonging to me.

1.31 Rights with respect to stocks or securities. To take all actions, directly or by proxy, discretionary or otherwise, and to exercise all rights of an owner, with respect to any stock or security owned by me.

1.32 Waiver of potential conflicts. To do any act authorized herein irrespective of the fact that my Agent and I both have or may have conflicting or opposite interest in any act herein authorized.



1.33 Miscellaneous powers. And generally, for the full execution of the purposes aforesaid, my Agent is authorized to do and perform, and to make, sign and execute, in the name of Principal all acts and written instruments with all usual and customary clauses, that shall or may be required and necessary, and bind Principal thereby as firmly as if the same were, or had been, the Principal's own acts and deeds; and, also, to do and perform all and every other act, matter and things whatsoever conducive to the interest of Principal, whether the same be an act of administration merely or any act of alienation, as shall or may be requisite and necessary, touching or concerning the affairs, business and concerns of Principal, as fully, amply and effectually, and to all intents and purposes with the same validity, as if all and every such act, matter or thing were, or had been, herein particularly stated, expressed and especially provided for, or as the Principal could or might do if personally present; all with full power of substitution and revocation.

1.34 Ratification. Principal does hereby ratify and confirm all that my Agent or my Agent's substitute shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue of this act or procuration.

## ARTICLE 11

### HEALTH CARE

I give my Agent all powers regarding the following health care matters that I could exercise on my own behalf, if capable of doing so. My Agent may:

2.1 General. Make all and every kind of health care decision for me which shall include the powers described in the subsequent provisions.

2.2 Medical records. Have access to any medical information in any form regarding my physical or mental condition, and to execute such consents as may be necessary to obtain it. Act as the Principal's personal representative under the HIPAA regulations and to act on behalf of the Principal with regard to any other federal, state, local or any other public programs which require authority from the Principal to act.

2.3 Professionals. Retain, compensate and discharge any health care professionals my Agent deems necessary to examine, evaluate or treat me, whether for emergency, elective, recuperative, convalescent or other care.

2.4 Institutionalization. Admit me to any health care facility recommended by a qualified health care professional, whether for physical or mental care or treatment, and remove me from such institution at any time, even if contrary to medical advice.

2.5 Treatment. Consent on my behalf to tests, treatment, medication, surgery, organ transplant or other procedures, and to revoke that consent, even if contrary to medical advice.


2.6 Chemical dependency. Consent on my behalf to a course of treatment for chemical dependency, whether suspected or diagnosed, and to revoke such consent.

2.7 Pain relief. Consent on my behalf to pain relief procedures, even if they are unconventional or experimental, even if their use may risk addiction, injury or foreshortening my



life.

2.8 Releases. Release from liability any health care professional or institution that acts on my behalf in reliance on my Agent.

  
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ARTICLE III  
PERSONAL CARE

I give my Agent all powers regarding the following personal care matters that I could exercise on my own behalf, if capable of doing so. My Agent may:

3. Home care. Provide for my continued maintenance and support. As nearly as possible, I desire to maintain my accustomed standard of living. My Agent shall provide me with a suitable place to live, by maintaining me in my family residence or apartment (home), paying principal, interest, taxes, insurance and repairs as necessary. My Agent may retain or discharge domestic servants, attendants, companions, nurses, sitters or other persons who provide care for me and my home. My Agent may authorize purchases of food, clothing, medical care and customary luxuries on my behalf.

3.2 Institutional care. If recommended by my physician, my Agent may contract for institutional health care (hospital, retirement facility, nursing home, hospice other) on my behalf. If reasonably advised that my return home is unlikely because of my condition, my Agent may sell, exchange, lease, sublease or dispose of my home and such of its contents as are no longer useful to me and are not specifically bequeathed in my will, all on such terms as to price, payment and security as my Agent deems reasonable.

3.3 Religious needs. Continue my affiliation with my church, keeping me accessible to its clergy, members and other representatives, continuing and renewing any pledge made by me whether for capital, operations or other purposes, and generally to assist me in maintaining my church relationships to the extent my health permits.

3.4 Companions and recreation. Hire, discharge, direct and compensate such companions as may be necessary for my health, recreation, travel and general well-being.

3.5 Funeral arrangements. Arrange and contract for my funeral, including appropriate arrangements and instructions for my funeral service or memorial service, including purchase of a burial plot or other appropriate disposition of my body. My Agent shall comply with such known written instructions as I may have or leave.

3.6 Curator or guardian. Nominate on my behalf any person my Agent deems qualified (including my Agent) as my curator, undercurator, curator ad hoc, guardian, or conservator or any other fiduciary office I have a right to nominate or designate, to waive any bond on my behalf and to grant to that fiduciary or representative any powers that I might extend on my own behalf.

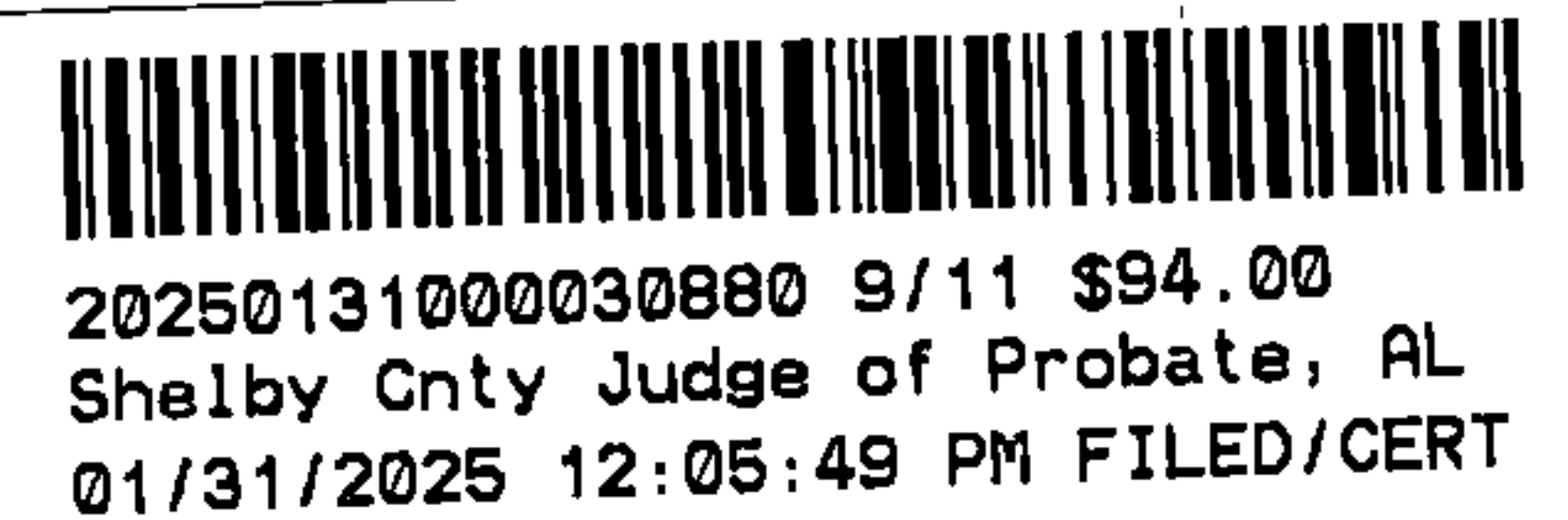
ARTICLE IV  
INCIDENTAL POWERS

To enforce exercise of the powers granted in this document and to the extent I could act on my own behalf if capable, my Agent may:

- 4.1 Proceedings. Institute or defend any lawsuit or administrative proceedings on my behalf.
- 4.2 Advisors and employees. Hire, compensate, instruct and discharge attorneys, accountants, appraisers, experts, consultants or other advisors, employees or independent contractors my Agent deems necessary.
- 4.3 Modifications. Amend this document as may be necessary to exercise the powers granted herein.
- 4.4 Communications. Open, read, respond to and redirect any written communications directed to me; represent me before any postal authority, messenger service, or information service relevant matters.
- 4.5 Important documents. Disclose, copy or deny access to any document; exercise my privilege of confidentiality and generally to care for and protect all information relevant to me, in any form.
- 4.6 Pets. Provide continuing care for my pets or other animals owned by me or in my care, and contract and pay for their welfare.

#### ARTICLE V

#### MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS



- 5.1 Expenses. My Agent shall be entitled to reimbursement for all costs and expenses reasonably incurred on my behalf, but shall not otherwise be entitled to compensation for services rendered.
- 5.2 Information. Persons who receive requests for information from my Agent are authorized to furnish it, as and when requested. I release them from any and all legal liability for furnishing the information my Agent requests. If that information is privileged, I waive the privilege. My Agent may disclose that information to such others as my Agent may deem appropriate.
- 5.3 Nomination. I nominate my Agent to serve as my curator, guardian, conservator and in any similar fiduciary capacity consonant with the powers granted in this agency.
- 5.4 Release. I release and discharge my Agent and my Agent's heirs, successors and assigns from any and all liability to me, my heirs, successors and assigns arising out of any acts or omissions of my Agent, except for willful misconduct or gross negligence. My Agent shall have no responsibility to make my property productive of income, to increase the value of my estate or to diversify my investments.
- 5.5 Applicable law. This instrument shall be governed by the laws of Alabama.
- 5.6 Revocation. removal. amendment and resignation. My Agent may be removed by me at any time by written document executed by me, when competent mentally and physically to do so, and delivered to my Agent. If this agency has been recorded in the public records, the act of revocation, amendment or removal shall be filed or recorded in the same manner. My Agent may resign by written resignation delivered to me or,

if I am incapacitated or interdicted, by delivery to any person with whom I am residing or who is responsible for my care.

5.7 Durable power of Attorney. This power of attorney shall not terminate upon the disability, infirmity, competence or incapacity of me, but rather it is the specific intention of me to authorize and direct my Agent to carry out the power and authority granted my Agent hereunder. In such event, notwithstanding such disability, infirmity, incompetence or incapacity, all acts done by my Agent during any period of disability, infirmity, incompetence or incapacity shall have the same effect and shall inure to the benefit of and bind me to the same full extent as if such disability, infirmity, incompetence or incapacity had not occurred.

5.8 Notice after amendment or termination. I hereby ratify and confirm, and promise at all times to ratify and confirm, all and whatsoever my Agent shall lawfully do between the amendment, expiration or revocation of this power of attorney and notice of such amendment, expiration or revocation reaching my Agent; and I do hereby declare that everything which my Agent shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such amendment, expiration or revocation, shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who, before the doing thereof, shall not have had actual or constructive notice of such amendment, expiration or revocation.

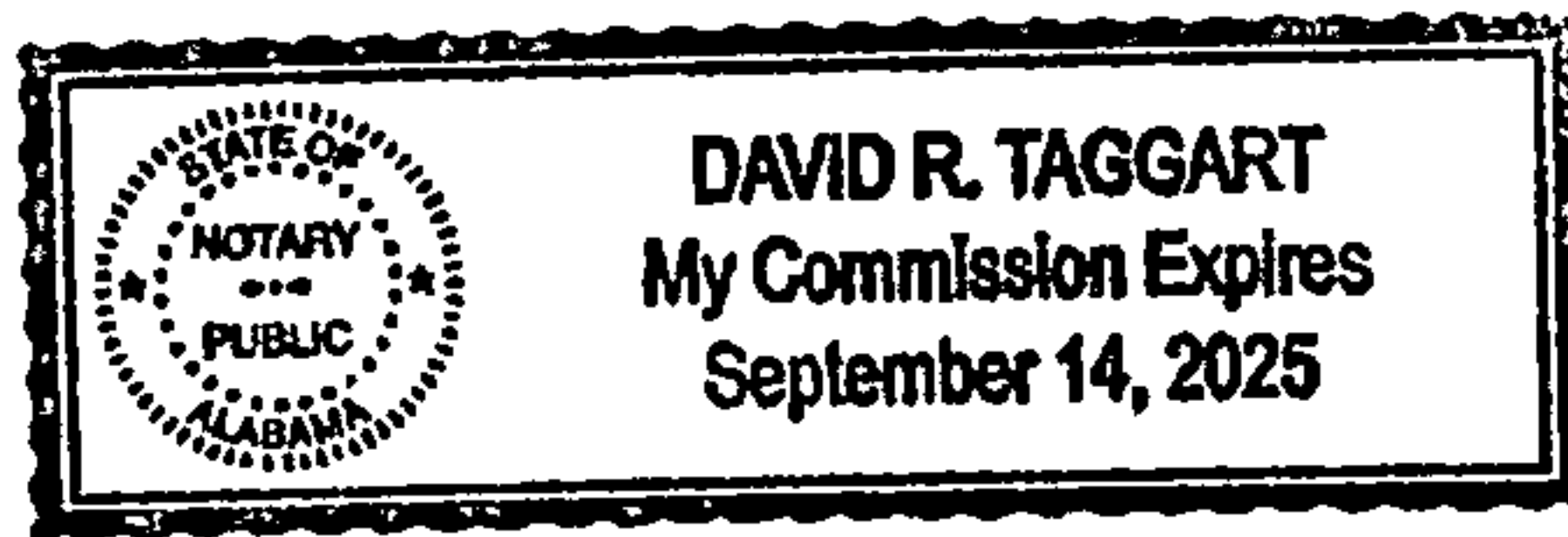
