KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, **Rubye Yvonne Crumpler**, a legal resident of Shelby County, State of Alabama, United States of America, anticipating that a Power of Attorney may be useful in certain circumstances, have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint, **Hannibal Crumpler**, as my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, to act in, manage and conduct all my estate and all my affairs and for that purpose for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit and as my act and deed, to do and execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds and things, that is to say:

- (1) To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire, to sell, convey, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claim or otherwise encumber or dispose of; or to contract or agree for the acquisition, disposal or encumbrance of any property whatsoever, real, personal or mixed, or any custody, possession, interest, or right therein, upon such terms as my said attorney shall think proper;
- (2) To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, or let, or otherwise manage any or all of my property or any interest therein; to eject, remove, or relieve tenant or other persons from and recover possession of such property by all lawful means; and to maintain, protect, preserve, insure, remove, store, transport, repair, rebuild, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof;
- (3) To make, do and transact all and every kind of business of what nature or kind soever, including the receipt, recovery, collection, payment, compromise, settlement and adjustment of all accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends, annuities, retirement accounts, life or health insurance funds, demands, debts, taxes and obligations, which may now or hereafter be due, owing, or payable by me or to me;
- (4) To make, endorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds, assignments, agreement, certificates, hypothecations, checks, notes, bonds, vouchers, receipts and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary, convenient, or proper in the premises; to borrow funds, to lend funds, to forgive and collect debts; to create and fund inter vivos trusts and to enter into, execute, and negotiate buy-sell agreements; to complete charitable pledges;
- (5) To deposit and withdraw for the purposes hereof, in either my said attorney's name or my name or jointly in both our names, in or from any banking institution, any funds, negotiable paper, or monies which may come into my said attorney's hands as such attorney or which I now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to, and to have access to any safety deposit box that I may have;
- (6) To institute, prosecute, defend, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal, equitable, or administrative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, arrests, distresses or other proceedings, or otherwise engage in litigation in connection with the premises;
- (7) To act as my attorney or proxy in respect to any stocks, shares, bonds, or other investments, rights or interests, I may now or hereafter hold; to make statutory elections and disclaimers;
- (8) To engage, dismiss and pay agents, counsel, and employees, and to appoint and remove at pleasure any substitute for, or agent of my said attorney, in respect to

all or any of the matters or things herein mentioned and upon such terms as my attorney shall think fit;

- (9) To prepare, execute and file income and other tax returns, and other governmental reports, applications, requests and documents, and to settle tax disputes, to sign Internal Revenue Service powers of attorney.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetency, or incapacity of the principal, and I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding upon myself and my heirs, legal and personal representatives, and assigns whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said attorney.

In the event **Hannibal Crumpler** predeceases me or for any reason is incapable or unwilling to serve as such Power of Attorney, then I appoint **Alexander Crumpler**, as Power of Attorney with all the rights and powers stated hereinabove. Should both **Hannibal Crumpler and Alexander Crumpler** predecease me or for any reason are incapable or unwilling to serve as such Power of Attorney, then I appoint **Christopher Bryan Crumpler** as Power of Attorney with all the rights and powers stated herein above.

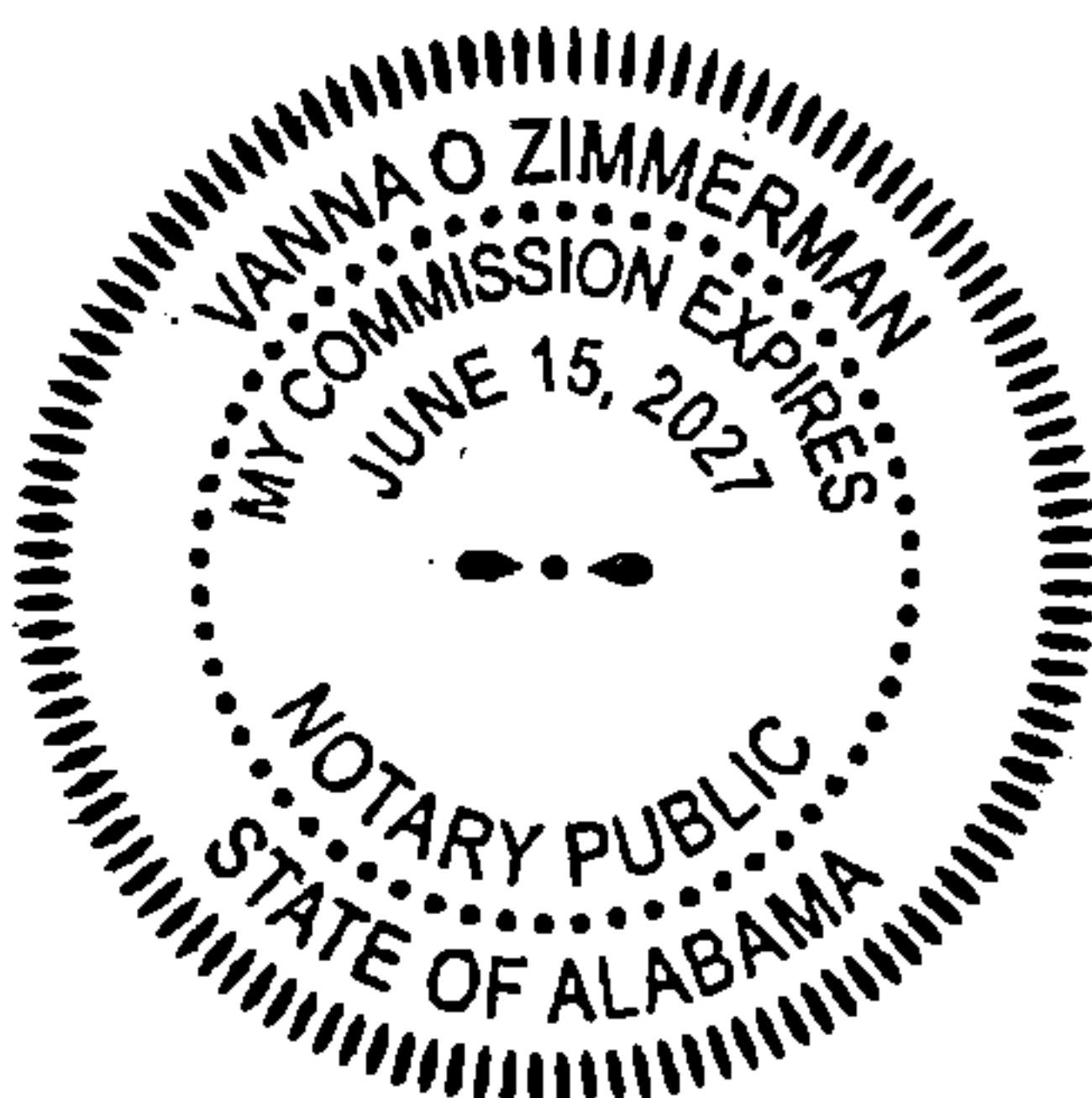
