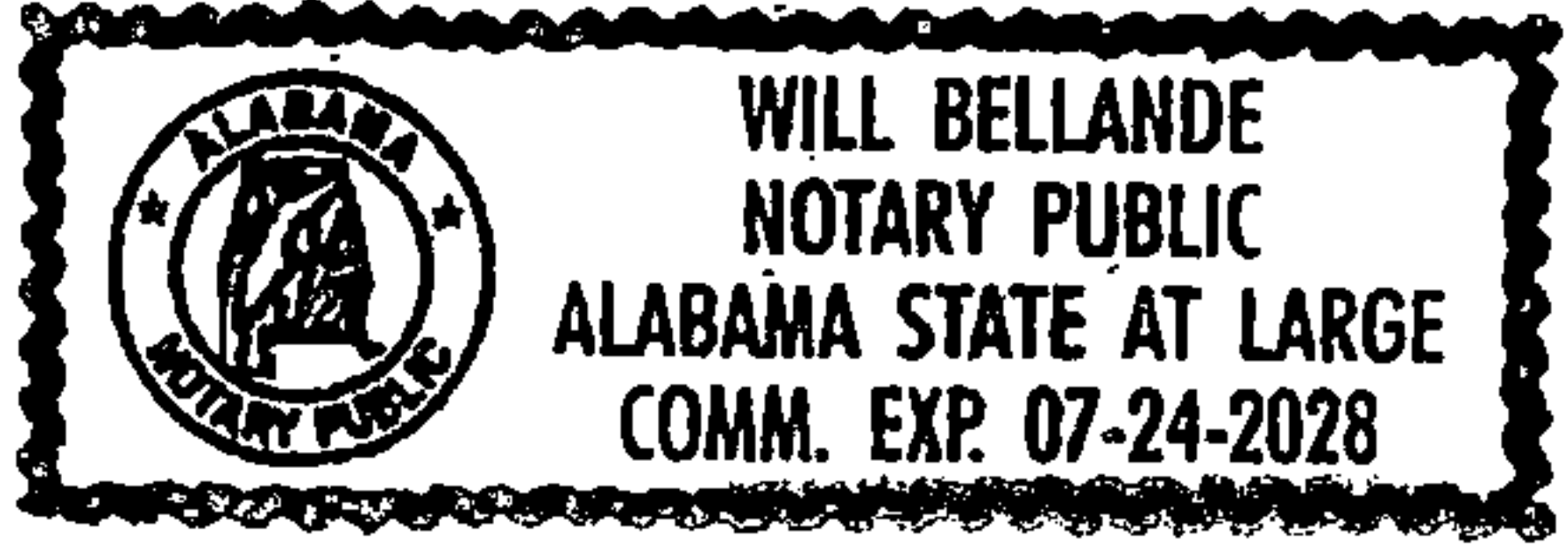

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

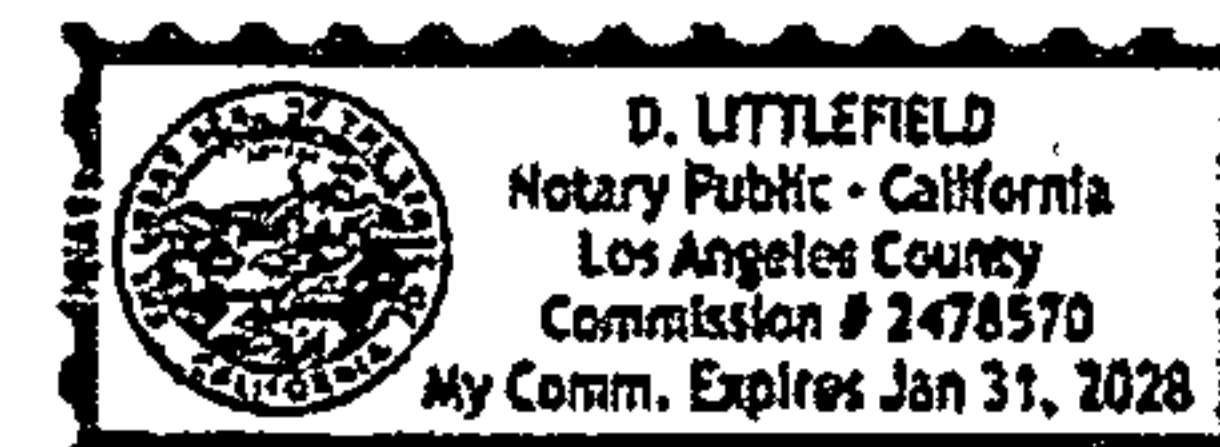

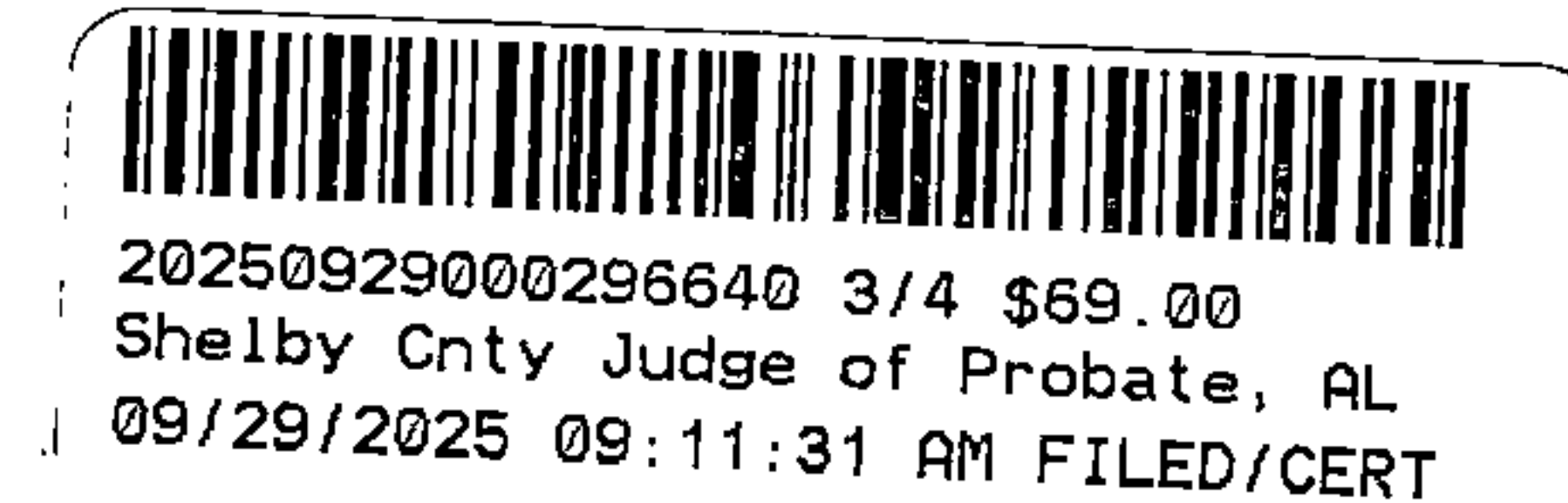

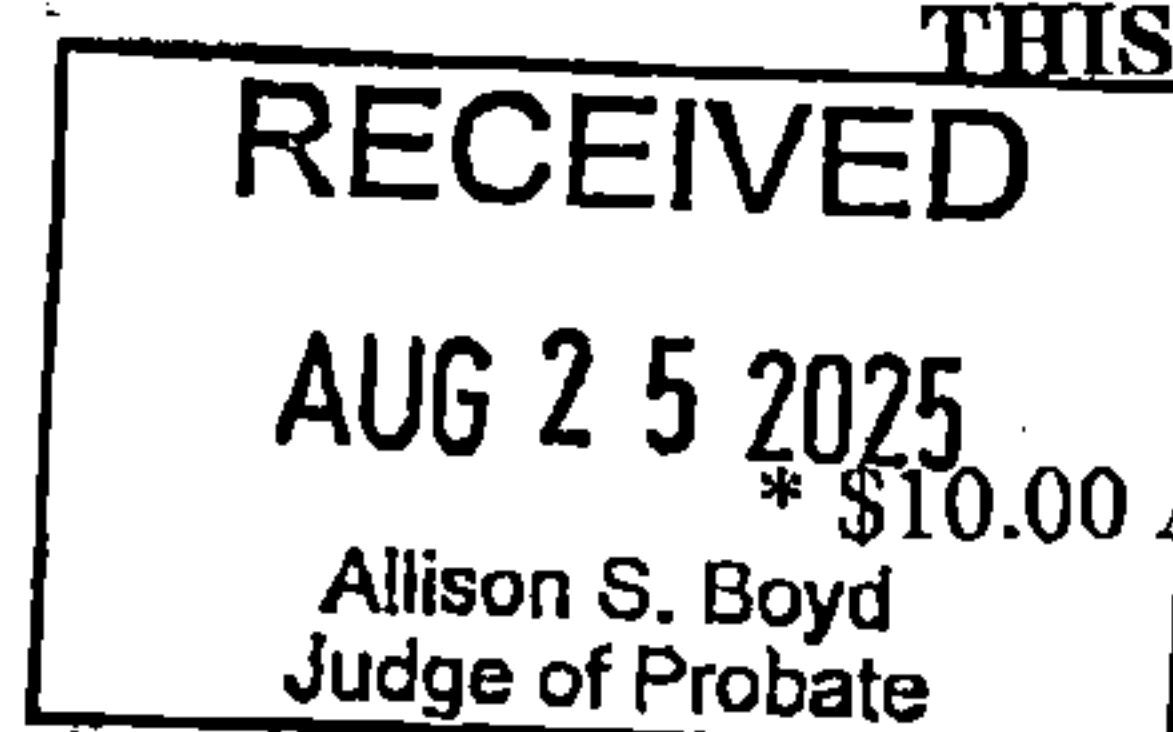
