I hereby nominate and appoint Frances Earley Ingram as Personal Representative of this my Last Will and Testament, and I direct that my said Personal Representative shall not be required to give bond or file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any Court. In

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the event of the death or the failure or refusal to act of my named Personal Representative, either before or after my death, I hereby nominate and appoint Melanie B. Johnston, as alternate Personal Representative of this my Last Will and Testament, and I direct that she shall not be required to give bond or to file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any Court.

I hereby direct that my said Personal Representative or alternate Personal Representative, whichever may serve hereunder, shall have full power and authority to determine what property, or undivided interest in property shall pass under each of the provisions of this Will, to be evidenced by bills of sale or conveyance or other evidence of title to each of the beneficiaries herein, such decision to be final in each case for all purposes under this Will, and except for property specifically bequeathed or devised hereunder, the particular property to pass under any provision of this Will shall be that property so determined and as evidenced by such instruments.

I hereby direct that my said Personal Representative, shall have, in addition to and not in limitation of the powers given by law or by other provisions of this Will, all those powers, duties, authorities or exemptions as are set forth in Section 43-2-843, 1975 Code of Alabama as amended, and shall also have, without prior approval of any Court, those powers, duties, authorities and exemptions as are set forth in Section 43-2-844, 1975 Code of Alabama, as amended.
