**DECREE ON PARTIAL SETTLEMENT & MOTION TO RELEASE FUNDS**

This cause came on to be heard on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2025 on the Interim Accounting and Motion To Approve Interim Accounting, Authorize Reimbursement, Approve Motion For Release of Funds, Or, In The Alternative, To Set Hearing filed by Karen McCall, as Personal Representative of the estate of Kendrick Jamahal Jackson. Due and proper notice of these proceedings having been provided in strict accordance of law to those entitled to same; the court proceeded to examine the accounting submitted by the Personal Representative. Present in open court for the hearing were: Karen McCall, along with Juanita M. Hayes, Esq., her attorney of record.

It appears from the evidence presented that for the period of June 6, 2024 through January 22, 2025, the Personal Representative is chargeable with receipts in the amount of \$0.00 and entitled to credits in the amount of \$0.00; and reports a balance on hand of \$33,325.14, which is being held in the Court's fiduciary account. The following are awarded and due to be paid:


Shelby County Probate Court (court costs – outstanding and current)	\$149.73

The Personal Representative having posted good and sufficient surety in the amount of \$39,000.00, the Clerk of Court shall make payment of the Court costs and release the remaining funds and any interest thereupon to Karen McCall, as Personal Representative of the estate of Kendrick Jamahal Jackson; whose Letters of Administration are due to be REINSTATED.

The Personal Representative shall prepare and file an Annual Accounting for the period of December 17, 2025 through December 31, 2026 on or before February 15, 2027.

Costs of Court are taxed to the estate of Kendrick Jamahal Jackson, for which let execution issue.
