ORDER REVOKING LETTERS AND REQUIRING
BONDING COMPANY TO FILE SETTLEMENT

This matter came before the Court on January 7, 2026 for Status/Noncompliance Hearing for failure to file documents necessary to support and proceed with a Final Settlement in this matter. This Court entered an Order requiring the Personal Representative to file an Annual Accounting or Final Settlement as required by Statute on December 4, 2024. In response thereto, the Personal Representative filed a document styled as an Inventory wherein she listed estate assets of \$43,000.00. On or about July 28, 2025, the Personal Representative filed a Petition for Consent Settlement of Decedent's Ancillary Estate, listing therein the decedent's next of kin from whom consents were necessary to proceed to final settlement. The Petition was deficient as it was not notarized, was not supported by consents signed by all next-of-kin listed in the petition, and did not provide proof of notification to Alabama State Medicaid Office. A Deficiency Notice was sent by the Court on or about July 29, 2025 to notify counsel of the noted deficiencies.

An Amended Petition was filed along with proof of notice to Medicaid, but the necessary consents were not filed with the Court, thus the matter was set for Status/Noncompliance. Neither the Personal Representative nor her attorney appeared for the Status/Noncompliance Docket at 10:00 AM on January 7, 2026.

The Letters of Administration previously issued by this Court to Ambre Morrison are due to be and hereby are revoked pending further Order of the Court. The Personal Representative's Surety, State Farm Fire and Casualty Insurance Company, is hereby ORDERED to file documents



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necessary to proceed with a Consent Final Settlement or in the alternative to prepare and file a Final Settlement of this administration within **thirty (30)** days hereof.
