

POWER OF ATTORNEY

6. To enter safe deposit boxes
7. To engage in insurance transactions
8. To engage in retirement plan transactions
9. To handle interests in estates and trusts
10. To pursue claims and litigation
11. To receive government benefits
12. To pursue and handle tax matters
13. To borrow money, including, but not limited to, the power to pledge, mortgage or create a security interest in any and all property held by me as security therefore, upon such terms as to said attorney shall seem fit, with full power to make, execute, acknowledge, and deliver such mortgages or other assignments as shall be necessary to effectuate this purpose; and to make loans
14. To create a trust for my benefit
15. To make additions to an existing trust for my benefit
16. To claim an elective share of the estate of my deceased spouse

17. To disclaim any interest in property
18. To renounce fiduciary positions
19. To withdraw and receive the income or corpus of a trust
20. To authorize and apply for my admission to a medical, nursing, residential, assisted living or similar facility
21. To authorize medical and surgical procedures
22. To carry on any business interest
23. To engage and dismiss agents, counsel, and employees
24. To enter into, perform, modify, extend, cancel, compromise, enforce, or otherwise act with respect to any contract of any sort whatsoever
25. To appoint a successor or successors as Agent hereunder if all of the Agent herein designated shall fail to qualify or cease to act hereunder
26. To execute any leases for any property in my name
27. To give property without consideration in any amount to any one or more of my spouse and descendants, outright or in trust, so long as my Agent believes that after such gifts sufficient funds will remain to provide for my welfare

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said Agent full power and authority to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person, if personally present, the above specially enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete, and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said Agent shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

Any Agent acting under this power of attorney shall not be liable for any acts of commission or omission performed in good faith and shall be liable only for deliberate and intentional defalcation.

It is my intent, and I hereby do direct, that this Power of Attorney shall not be terminated or otherwise affected by my subsequent disability or incapacity. All acts done by any of my Agent pursuant to this Power of Attorney during any such period, in which I am disabled or incapacitated, shall have the same effect and shall be binding upon my heirs, administrators and successors in interest just as if I were competent and not disabled.
