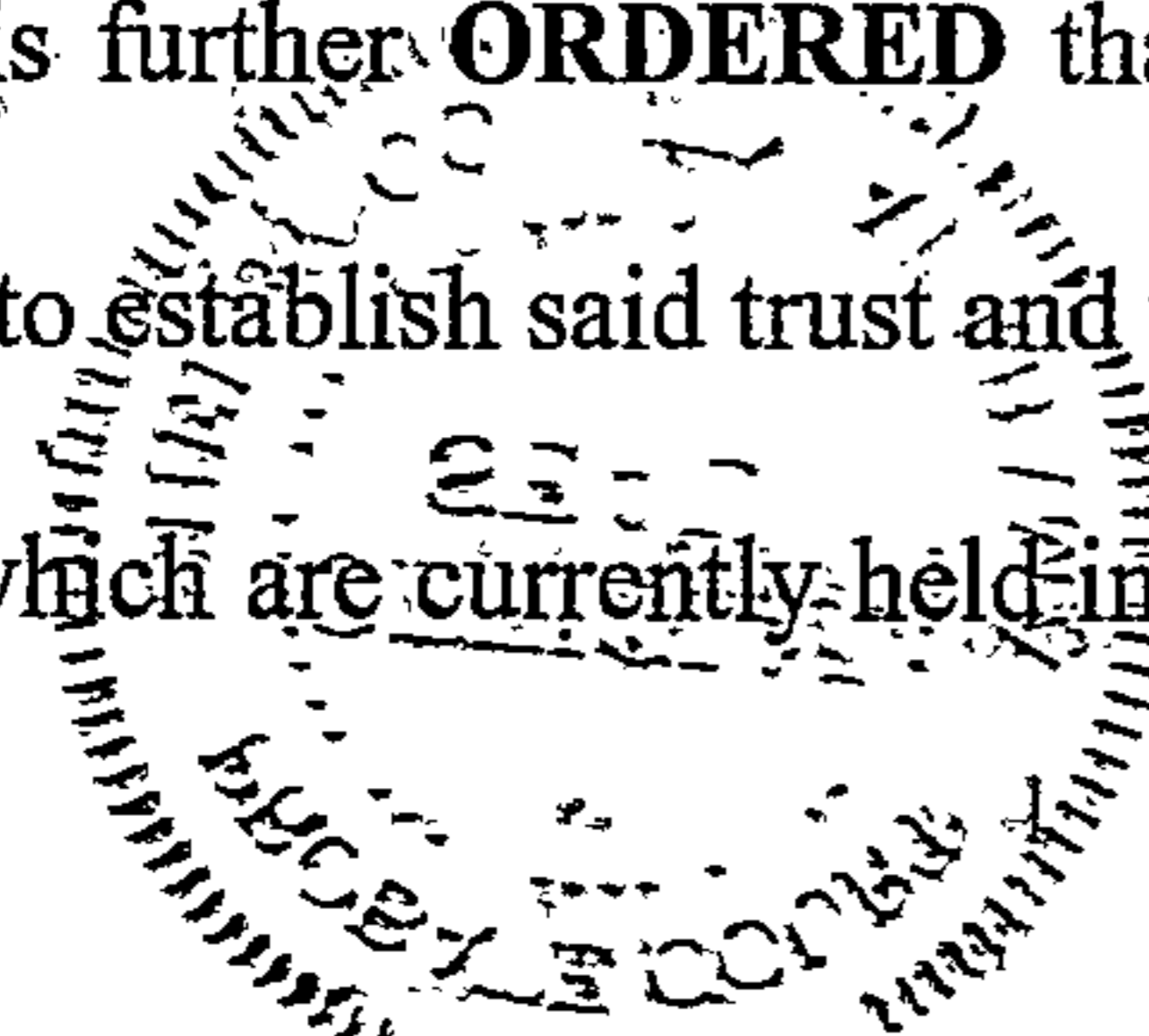
**ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL CONSERVATOR
FOR SINGLE TRANSACTION**

This matter came before this Court on March 31, 2026, on a Petition for Appointment of Special Conservator for Single Transaction filed by Jonathan Morgan, by and through his attorney of record, Lindsey Eastwood. Present at this hearing were the following: Petitioner and Natural Parent of the minor, Jonathan Morgan, along with his attorneys of record, Lindsey Eastwood and Ashley Rushton. The minor, Baxley Gibbs Morgan, did not appear but was represented by Attorney Wendy Ann Hartley-Gregerson who was heretofore appointed by this Court to act as his Guardian *ad Litem*.

After reviewing the Petition for Appointment of Special Conservator for Single Transaction, this Court finds good cause to grant the Petition.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Petition for Appointment of Special Conservator for Single Transaction be and is hereby GRANTED, in accordance with Section §26-2A-137 of the Code of Alabama, 1975. Jonathan Morgan is authorized to create and fund a special needs trust for the benefit of the minor. Further, Jonathan Morgan is authorized to obtain and deposit funds from the Estate of Natalie Lynn Morgan, which are currently held in Eastwood Estate & Probate Law's IOLTA for the benefit of the minor. No surety bond is required at this time.

It is further **ORDERED** that Jonathan Morgan is authorized to execute all documents necessary to establish said trust and to oversee payments of funds from the Estate of Natalie Lynn Morgan, which are currently held in Eastwood Estate & Probate Law's IOLTA for the benefit of

the minor, directly to the special needs trust or a financial account titled to the special needs trust with Jonathan Morgan named as Trustee for the minor and with the minor named as beneficiary.

It is further **ORDERED** that the costs of Court incurred herein, are taxed against the Estate, for which let execution issue.
